CATHOLIC FAMILY MOVIE NIGHT SERIES: "PRISONER"

Destined to go down as one of the great, on-going American film festivals, the St. Angela Merici Catholic Family Movie Night series rolls along, our next feature being shown this coming Friday, October 14, at 7:00PM in the lunchroom. It's the 1955 classic, "Prisoner", starring the late, great, Oscar-winning Catholic actor, Sir Alec Guinness. Guinness portrays an eastern-bloc cardinal who winds up in the Soviet gulag for speaking against the atrocities of Communism. Though fictional, it's obviously patterned after the real life trials and tortures of the great Josef Cardinal Mindszenty of Hungary, who, at the very time this movie was made, was languishing in an Hungarian prison. In 1955, the Movie Industry was eager to distance itself from its Communist past, having gone "all in" for Stalin and, as we found out later, for Hitler, too, in the 1930's. That was then. Now, Hollywood has completely reverted to form, going back to its commie roots and now even makes movies celebrating the likes of Dalton Trumbo. Trumbo, and the other Hollywood commies, were the "true believing" sort, who became pro-Hitler when the Communist party told them to (after the Hitler-Stalin Pact) and reversed themselves and became anti-Hitler when Hitler betrayed Stalin (all the while remaining faithful to Stalin). Though Stalin was the man who had Minszenty tortured and thrown into prison, Hollywood now portrays Trumbo and his ilk, Stalin's stooges, as the martyrs because they were "blacklisted" and could no longer earn the big bucks they had been pulling in after their complicity with the Communist Party USA was discovered! Guinness does his usual masterful job. It's a great flick. (Free pop and popcorn, of course!)

7. This Spanish Carmelite reformer is a doctor of the Church, an advisor to St. John of the Cross and a friend of St. Ignatius Loyola; her feast is on Oct. 15.
8. He’s founder of the Passionists and his feast on Oct. 20.
9. Outrage over this saintly pope’s merciful attitude toward sinners caused the ascendance of the first anti-pope. He was martyred in 223AD and his feast is on Oct. 14.
10. Though not celebrated this year because their feast (Oct. 2) fell on Sunday, these heavenly protectors are assigned to guard each one of us.




