They have been here before, usually coming to our parish every year-and-a-half or so, and I'm sure most of you remember them. They are victims of persecution from ISIS/ISIL and this is just about the only way they are able to support themselves. Let us welcome them when they come. And on the same weekend...

...THE ANNUAL FLORISSANT CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

What began 150 or so years ago had been revived and perpetuated in our time, namely, the great Eucharistic Procession on the feast dedicated to the mystery of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. It has become our heritage as citizens of the proud and historic city of Florissant. It starts at 1:30PM in Sacred Heart church on May 29. Special invitations are given to our first communicants to have pride of place in the procession, wearing their First Communion apparel.

LOURDES - THE "NON-VIRTUAL" TOUR




