## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

***REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!***

### **BEYOND SUNDAY**

This major archdiocesan collection (the third in the last 20 years) has been going on for over a year now in roughly two-thirds of the other parishes of the archdiocese and will soon begin here. The archdiocese is trying to raise 100 million dollars to support our parish schools. It's quite an ambitious undertaking, and everyone will be asked to make a major contribution.

Of course our schools are worth it and they certainly do need it, and so our parish will accept and embrace its portion. There's much work to be done, and leaders and workers are needed for it. If you love our parochial school system, have benefitted from it, would like to see it still be there for your grandchildren, and would be willing to help, then please make yourself known to me. The whole process starts in a couple of months.

### **SHAW'S GARDEN NORTH**

It's spring, and the St. Angela Gardeners have sprung into action. In a flurry of unsurpassed planting, they have turned our parish grounds into another Eden. 




