



OLIVE WOOD CRUCIFIX

As I mentioned last week, I had our top local liturgical artist come out and take a look at our new crucifix for the purpose of figuring out how best to display it in our parish church. She recommended (and I agreed) that we fabricate a wood panel comparable to the one behind the crucifix in the front of church and suspend it above the doors where we all depart church. She's working on the design now and I hope that it will be in place, beautifully, in the next month or two. My thanks, again, to you all for the overwhelmingly generous response to this project!

"Tantony pig", after St. Anthony the Abbot 3. "St. Vitus dance" 4. "St. Cuthbert's duck" 5. "(St.) Catherine's wheel" 6. "Filbert" (after St. Philibert) 7. "(St.) Bartholomew pig" (after the large pig usually roasted at the festival on St. Bartholomew's Day, giving rise to simile: "e's as fat as Bartholomew's Pig!") 8. "St. Bernard" (the Augustinian Canons at the monastery of St. Bernard in Switzerland had trained them) 9. "St. Crispin's holiday" (St. Crispin is the patron of shoemakers, who, in England, always took Monday off) 10. "St. Francis' distemper" (St. Francis of Assisi, of course, preached and chose to live radical poverty, as did his followers, the Franciscans; this refers to the state of radical poverty imposed upon one by sad fate and reversal of fortune)




S.A.M. St. Vincent de Paul Society Semi-Annual Report

In an effort to be good stewards of the contributions made to the SVDP Society, we continue to make home visits in teams of two Vincentians to assess the needs of our clients.

- From Jan. 1 to July 1, our members made 87 home visits. There were 351 persons in the households that were visited.
- The Vincentian hours involved in those home visits were 222. In addition, there are many phone hours involved.
- Assistance was given to 42 families to avoid Laclede disconnection.
- Assistance was given to 57 families to avoid Ameren disconnection.
- Assistance was given to 4 families to avoid MO-AM water disconnection.
- In addition to utility assistance we were able to help people with Thrift Store vouchers to help with clothing and household furnishings. We were able to get these vouchers because of the terrific response April 2/3 when the SVDP truck was in St. Angela's parking lot, collecting clothing and household goods.
- We continue to be one of the largest contributors to the TEAM food pantry with our monthly Food Drives. We also take food boxes to some of our clients. When store and gas gift cards are donated, we are able to distribute those also.
- We were able to help 9 families through the Beds for Neighbors SVDP Program.
- The LDI prescription program enabled us to help 3 families with medications.
- So far this year, we disbursed \$14,732 donated by the generous parishioners at St. Angela Merici in the parish SVDP envelopes, the brown envelopes at the back of church and the Men's Club supper.

Through the Main Council Office of the SVDP Society we were able to utilize funds from other resources such as, the Rise-n-Shine fund raiser, Community Action, Heat Up, \$More, the SVDP North District and "twinning" with other parishes' SVDP Societies and the Marian Foundation.

We are very grateful to the parishioners at St. Angela Merici for their financial contributions, the Food Drive donations and the Spring clothing and household collection.
