From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JULY IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS!

PILGRIMS ASSEMBLE!

The response to our proposed pilgrimage to Lourdes/Fatima/Assisi/Rome has been overwhelming. Consequently, I have scheduled a brainstorming/planning session together with travel agent, Jeff Stoll, to which everyone who has any interest at all in joining us is invited. Jeff is known to many of you already. He and his beautiful family are parishioners at Sacred Heart and Jeff was, for a while, a couple of years behind me in the seminary. So set this date: Wednesday, July 20, at 7:00PM in the parish lunchroom. As I say, anyone who has the least interest in this is welcome to attend (and if you can't make it to this meeting, you can still go!). I hope, by the end of the meeting, to have a clearer picture of the optimal time to go and the most efficient travel plans so as to make the best use of time, and also all the things that our group wants to see.

PIANO RECITAL

Next Sunday afternoon at 2:00 in our parish center (the air-conditioned Buckley-Montine Building), star pianist (and our parishioner), Danny Kuehler, will perform a benefit concert of piano music. There will be no admission fee, but, rest assured, a hat will be passed by concert's end! He will give us more than hour of great music, playing selections from Beethoven, Brahms, Scarlatti, Bach, Chopin, Rachmaninov, and Schumann. A grand piano has been rented for the event and a treat for the ears is virtually guaranteed (even though, sadly, Ray Charles didn't make it onto the short list!). Danny is performing this in order to raise money for his further education and mastery of the instrument in Europe. You will be edified.

OLIVE WOOD CRUCIFIX

We have already exceeded our goal to cover the cost of the crucifix itself, and the leftover funds will be used to prepare a proper setting for this beautiful work of art and devotion. This past Thursday, I met with St. Louis' top liturgical artist, Michel Bowman of Restorations Plus, and am working with her to come up with the best presentation of it, so that we can benefit from it the best. Before long, it will be placed in church, most likely over the back doors so that you can see the main cross as you enter, and this secondary cross as you leave.

Tomorrow (Monday) being our national Independence Day, we will, as our parish tradition dictates, have Mass at 9:00AM.

ANSWERS: 1. Crucified upside down in Nero's Circus (located between two hills: the Janiculum and the Vatican)
2. Crucified on an X-shaped cross in Patras, Greece
3. Died of natural causes in "extreme old age" in Ephesus
4. Take your pick: he was either stabbed in the back, crucified (though in his case he was not nailed to wood but rather to the ground) and died after he was miraculously saved from an attempt to burn him alive, or died in Persia (Iran) of natural causes
5. Died in India after having been run through by a spear
6. Crucified after having been first skinned alive and then beaten with clubs
7. Both were martyred together in Persia; they were first stoned, then Jude was run through with a spear and Simon was sawed in half with a broadsaw (starting at the crotch and working toward the head!) – when they saw the mob coming to kill them, Jude calmly turned to Simon and said, "I see the Lord is calling us"
8. Was crucified at age 87, upside down like St. Peter, in the persecutions of Domitian
9. The first of the Apostles to be martyred, James was beheaded by order of the corrupt King Herod, as recorded in the Acts of the Apostles
10. Being a Roman citizen, Paul could not be crucified. Nonetheless, he was executed by beheading in the same persecution as Peter, under the notorious emperor, Nero





