### **PASTOR OUT OF TOWN**

I will be gone next weekend (and the week after that, i.e., Friday, June 17-Friday, June 24. I'll be back up east again, sponging off my relatives. During that time, we will have Communion Services on the weekdays (ably supplied by our sturdy Deacon Joe Kroutil), but on the weekend...

### **...REDEMPTORISTS TO VISIT ST. ANGELA'S**

Next weekend, our parish will be visited by Fr. Joseph Corelli of the Redemptorist Fathers, who will offer all the Masses and make an appeal for their magazine, *The Liguorian*. Please welcome him.

### **UPDATES!**

In this column I will give you updates on several things that are hanging fire. Here goes:

1) **LOURDES/FATIMA/ROME/ASSISI PILGRIMAGE** - I have been in contact with a travel agent who specializes in Catholic pilgrimages. This is what I know for sure: it will take place in October of 2017. I also know that Oct. 13, 2017 will be the actual 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the great miracle of Fatima; what I don't know is whether that would be a wonderful time or terrible time to be there (because of the expected crowds). We're checking into it. We will stay in upscale hotels, and meals at upscale restaurants will be part of the package. The four destinations listed at the beginning of this paragraphs are the designated pilgrimage sites, but an off day will be scheduled so that anyone who might want to make an individual side trip (to, say, Florence, Pompeii, Venice, etc.) would be able to do so. Tour guides at each stop will be provided. It will cost roughly \$4,000 (covering air fare and coach, hotels, and most meals) per person for an eleven-day pilgrimage. The response was enthusiastic; I have more than 30 who expressed a desire to go.

2) **OLIVE WOOD CRICIFIX** - Talk about enthusiastic responses! We've already collected (as of last Tuesday) close to \$1,000. I think it will look beautiful in our church!

3) **BEYOND SUNDAY** - The big, archdiocesan-wide collection will soon be taken up in our parish. Its purpose is to ensure the viability of our wonderful Catholic schools here in the Archdiocese (which are the envy of the rest of the nation!) We are slated to be in the third and final tier (perhaps you know of people in other parishes who have already been asked to give and wondered why you haven't). As I say, it kicks off here in another month. All will be explained.

4) **CONFESSIONAL RENOVATION** - The expansion & soundproofing of my confessional will also be starting soon. I'm looking forward to its being a great improvement in our ability to celebrate that great sacrament as it should be.

5) **ESTATE PLANNING** - Don't forget that on Tuesday evening, July 12th, Bill Jochens will be here to help with this essential part of life. It's all free.

Great as our filial duty of reverence is toward whatever he may say, great as our duty of obedience must be to the guidance of the Chief Shepherd, we do not hold that every word of his is infallible, or that he must always be right. Much less do we dream of teaching that he is infallible, or in any degree superior to other men, when he speaks on matters that are scientific, or historical, or political, or that he may not make mistakes of judgment in dealing with contemporary events, with men and things.” - *Raphael Cardinal Merry del Val, explaining the dogma of papal infallibility to a Protestant*
