## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT DECEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION!**

### **A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION TO HONOR THE PATRONESS OF OUR LAND**

This coming Friday, December 8, is the feast of Our Lady's Immaculate Conception. Since it is under that exact title that she is the patroness of the United States of America, that day will always be a day when American Catholics will be obliged to attend Holy Mass to honor her and thank her for the patronage from which we have all benefitted greatly. We will have Mass on the Thursday evening before the feast (on Dec. 7) at 7:00PM, and then again on the day of the feast itself at 6:30 and 8:00AM. (Please note that Thursday's Mass is the only evening Mass.)

### **ADVENT**

There are two seasons in the Church's cycle of feasts and seasons where the designated color liturgical color is purple/violet. Lent, of course, is one and the other is Advent, the season in which we now find ourselves. The reason why is that they are both penitential seasons. Since Advent is a time for renewal it's a time for penance, though not as strict as Lent. Consequently, there will be extra times for Confession throughout this month, in addition to the usual Saturday Confessions from 4:00-4:45pm. (You will be receiving a letter from me soon with the schedule.) This holy season, short though it be, has its own distinct flavor, which is expressed magnificently through the saints whose feasts fall during this time, such as...

### **...ST. NICHOLAS AND ST. AMBROSE**

This Wednesday is the feast of St. Nicholas and on Thursday we honor the great Doctor of the Church, St. Ambrose. Yes, Virginia, there really *is* a Santa Claus, except he's really St. Nicholas. In commemoration of this great patron saint of children, we have the custom of the kiddies' putting out their shoes (or hanging up their socks) on the eve of his feast so that their saintly protector and provider can render them treats. (It's also a beautiful way to encourage the little ones to behave!) St. Ambrose is reckoned one of the great doctors of the Western Church (along with Jerome, Leo, Gregory, and Augustine). Mass is at 8:00AM each day. And don't forget...

### **...ADVENT VESPERS**

There's not a better way to keep the Advent season by, in addition to daily Mass and going to Confession, taking part in the Sunday Vespers. Celebrated in the evenings of the Sundays of Advent (with the exception this year of the last Sunday which, being Christmas Eve, will be celebrated instead on Thursday, Dec. 21). Our adult and children's choirs will chant the prophecies which foretold Our Savior's coming and we will fortify ourselves with the praise of God Almighty. Let everybody know that they're welcome to join us! And on a more epicureal note, don't forget...

### **...MEXICAN FOOD NIGHT, TO HONOR OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE**

Senor Don Krause has come up the perfect bill of fare to celebrate that moment when the Mother of God graced our continent with her presence! It is: Fajitas (steak, shrimp, chicken and toppings (build your own), Quesadillas (chicken, bacon, avocado & cheese combo), Mexican Lasagna, Tamales, Nachos con Queso (Mexican white cheese), beans & rice, Salad (build your own from Mexican toppings), and desserts: Carmel Cake, Baked Rice Pudding, Biscochitos (cookies), and you can wash it all down with Mexican cerveza (beer) or a margarita.
