## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

***REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!***

### **MY DEEPEST AND MOST HEARFELT THANKS**

I have been simply overwhelmed by the expressions of concern for my poor, rehabilitated hip, your kindness to me in my predicament, and the support of your (apparently very powerful) prayers! I have received many beautiful cards, notes, and letters, too many to respond to individually. As Chesterton said, “Thanks are the highest form of thought and gratitude is happiness doubled by wonder.” May God bless you all for your thoughtfulness on my behalf!

### **THE ADVENT OF LENT**

Yes, I know that Advent and Lent are two discrete seasons, but “advent” simply means “coming” and my point is that the holy season of Lent is coming soon (March 1, actually, only ten days away). We have many wonderful opportunities for spiritual growth and renewal. There’s all the traditional things (Confessions, Stations of the Cross, Eucharistic Adoration, daily Mass, etc.), of course, but we also have a wonderful speaker series lined up for the Fridays of Lent, much like we’ve done in the past. On Ash Wednesday itself (which occurs on the afore-mentioned March 1), there will be three Masses: at 6:30 & 8:00AM, and at 7:00PM. Also, don’t forget to bring up your old palms; there’s a special box in the vestibule for to receive them. (They’ll be burned for the ashes of Ash Wednesday.)

- **EAGLE PROJECT/LOURDES GROTTO** Our good parishioner, young Peter Hedlesky, is finishing up his Eagle Scout project, namely, transforming our outdoor shrine to the Blessed Mother into a *bonafide* Lourdes Grotto. It’s coming rapidly toward completion. The finished development will feature the kneeler that you see and a fountain of flowing water. I think it will look beautiful and fittingly honor the Mother of God. Our congratulations and thanks to him for undertaking this task!

**ANSWERS:** 1. The first part is from the Archangel Gabriel (at the Annunciation), the second part is from St. Elizabeth (at the Visitation), and nobody knows where the last part comes from, but its first form is found in the prayerbooks of the Camaldolese Monks in 1514 2. Although there have been numerous attributions for this prayer in history, the consensus of opinion now is that it was composed by Hermann Contractus (d. 1054), a severely crippled monk (which is what contractus means) 3. Though often ascribed to St. Ignatius Loyola, it was composed long before him, but we're not sure by whom; our best guess is Pope John XXII (d. 1316) 4. This prayer is most often attributed to St. Bernard of Clairvaux (d. 1153), although this is much disputed; if he didn't compose it, then we have no idea who did 5. Pope St. Damasus (d. 384) 6. The BVM and the angels (revealed at Fatima, 1917) 7. St. Francis of Assisi (d. 1226) 8. Pope Leo XIII (d. 1903) 9. St. Ignatius Loyola (d. 1556) 10. Jesus Christ

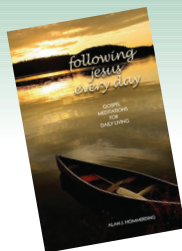
