REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART! AND A SPLENDID TIME WAS HAD BY ALL!

That was the consensus of those who came to our parish to honor St. Boniface last Monday (and sample a wide variety of German delicacies!). The place was **packed!** We served somewhere in the vicinity of 250 diners and grossed over \$3,500. The food was gourmet-quality and authentic, the decorations were spectacular, the service non-pareil, and the ambiance was pure *gemuetlichkeit!* All thanks and praise to *Kochmeister* Don Krause and his wonderful family. It was such a smash, that we've decided two things: first, this will definitely be an annual event, and, second, we're thinking of having an evening of *French cuisine* to honor our Florissant French heritage on the feast of the patron saint of France, King Louis IX, on Friday, August 25, his feast day. Anybody interested?

Commemorate the Centennial of Our Lady of Fatima at St. Angela Merici Parish

Our Lady made a series of appearances to the children at Fatima, Portugal on the 13th of the month from May to October, 1917. Her message was that if all prayed (especially the rosary), there would be peace. Tragically instead, over 300 million people died in the 20th century in wars and revolutions across the world. We still urgently need peace in our homes, families, region, country and the world.

To commemorate 100th anniversary of Fatima, Pope Frances has approved a plenary indulgence for the remission of ones' sins for the faithful who visit Fatima. He has also made this indulgence available to those who pray in the presence of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima on the 13th of the month from May to October this year. To receive the indulgence, one must also complete the usual conditions of praying for the intentions of the Pope, and receiving the Eucharist and going to Confession within 8 days before or after.

St. Angela Merici parish is blessed to have an Our Lady of Fatima statue, which will be specially displayed on the 13th of these months. You are most welcome to join in the parish rosary or pray on your own. If you are home bound, you may still receive the indulgence; please call the parish office (838-6969) to make arrangements to receive the sacraments.

Don't miss out on this wonderful spiritual opportunity for yourself, a loved one who has died, or a soul in purgatory who has no one to pray for them.

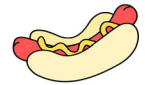

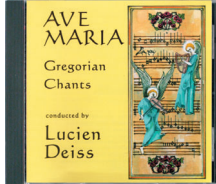
