4. What layman founded the first hospital in St. Louis (and west of the Mississippi)?
5. What great thing did Bryan Mullanphy & Dr. Moses Linton do in local Church history?
6. What two professional athletes have served as permanent deacons in the Archdiocese?
7. Name the various institutions of our archdiocese named for our former archbishops.
8. Who was the Catholic layman who helped change the map of Europe and form the nation of Czechoslovakia after World War I?
9. Name the oldest parish and the oldest church building in the archdiocese.
10. What St. Louis church was recently named the most beautiful church in the U. S.?

ANSWERS: 1. *Christian Brothers College (C.B.C.) 2. St. Rose of Lima (on Goodfellow Ave., now, sadly, closed)...only three teams showed up for the soccer event in 1904; the team from Canada won the gold and the St. Rose team tied two games and lost their other two (never scoring a goal) but won the bronze, anyway, because even though they finished last, last was third place, and third place means "bronze medal"!* 3. *When he died in 1858, Thornton left his entire fortune to the Archdiocese of St. Louis, some \$579,440.06 (probably worth over \$100,000,000 today)* 4. *John Mullanphy* 5. *Established the first foundation of the St. Vincent de Paul Society in America (1845)* 6. *Pro-Bowl linebacker Larry Stallings and Hall-of-Fame round-baller "Easy" Ed Macauley* 7. *Bp. DuBourg High School, Rosati-Kain High School (named for two former bishops), Kenrick Seminary (and there was a "Kenrick High School" years ago), Cardinal Glennon Hospital and Cardinal Glennon College, Cardinal Ritter College Prep High School, the Cardinal Carberry Campus (of Catholic Charities), and the Cardinal Rigali Center (formerly Kenrick Seminary), which is located on Archbishop May Drive in Shrewsbury, Mo.* 8. *Knight of St. Gregory, Dr. Hynek Dostal (who also edited the Czech-language newspaper, HLAS ["The Voice"])* 9. *Oldest parish: Ste. Genevieve (1759), oldest church: old St. Ferdinand Shrine (Florissant, 1821)* 10. *The church of my Baptism, St. Francis de Sales!*

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT (JANUARY THRU JUNE 2017)

In an effort to be good stewards of the contributions made to the SVDP Society, we continue to make home visits in teams of two Vincentians to assess the needs of our clients.

- From January 1 to June 30, our members made 94 home visits. In addition to the home visits, many contacts are made by phone. There were 422 persons helped by single or multiple visits to a household.
- There were 245 Vincentian hours involved in those home visits plus the many phone hours required.
- Assistance was given to 64 families to avoid Laclede disconnection.
- Assistance was given to 62 families to avoid Ameren disconnection.
- Assistance was given to 2 families to avoid MO-AM water disconnection.
- Through the Beds for Neighbors program we were able to get 12 beds for families.
- In addition to utility assistance, we were able to help people with SVDP Thrift Store vouchers to help with clothing & household vouchers. We were able to get Thrift Store vouchers because of the response when the SVDP truck was at St. Angela's in April.
- We continue to be one of the largest contributors to the TEAM food pantry with our monthly Food Drives which also allows us sometimes to take food packages directly to our clients.

In the first six months of this year we disbursed \$15,623 that had been donated by the generous parishioners at St. Angela's, from the envelope in the parish packet, the brown envelopes at the back of church, the Men's Club dinner & the Marian Foundation.

We have also received funds from the Main Council Office, the North District SVDP Society, the Rise-n-Shine Fund Raiser & the Bridges Fund. We were also able to help 4 families avoid eviction with the Rent Fund via the Main Council Office.

The members of the SVDP Society at St. Angela Merici appreciate the help of our generous parishioners in this ministry.

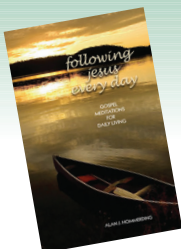
