From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!

FEAST OF ST. LOUIS IX, KING OF FRANCE, PATRON OF OUR ARCHDIOCESE

This Friday, August 25, is the feast of St. Louis IX of France, patron saint of our city, county, and archdiocese. It is a big day for us generally, but particularly for us at St. Angela's, because we're taking it as an occasion to offer...

...FRENCH FOOD NIGHT (*Une Soiree de Cuisine Francaise*)

Every parish has corned beef and cabbage on St. Patrick's Day, but here at St. Angela's we like to give all the saints, and the nationalities who benefit from their patronage, due tribute by serving their national foods on their feast days. Last June's German Food Night on St. Boniface's feast day was such a smash that we decided to have a night of French cuisine on the feast of St. Louis. Our *chef de la cuisine*, Monsieur Don Krause, will provide the French delicacies as Coldwater Creek is transformed into the Seine for this elegant evening of Gallic dining on its "left bank". Dinner starts at 4:30PM (and ends about 7:30), but will be preceded by...

...EUCHARISTIC ADORATION FOR ST. LOUIS

St. Louis was the very model of the ideal Catholic monarch, setting a powerful example for his people of personal holiness and tremendous faith. He was singularly devoted to the Blessed Sacrament, and so it is fitting that we will have a "holy hour" before dinner in church, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament and a holy relic of St. Louis himself. Adoration starts at 3:00PM.

"MINISTRY FAIR"

Although the response to this has not been extravagant, I still think it's a wonderful idea to set aside a certain Sunday to invite our parishioners to take a more active part in the life of the parish. So, look for it sometime soon.

UPCOMING EVENTS

- **September 5:** The return of my catechism class (which is held, usually, on the first and third Tuesdays of each month. All are welcome.
- **September 28:** We will honor St. Wenceslaus, patron of the Czechs, on his feast day with an evening of Czech food, including Veprova Pecene (roast pork), Knedliky (potato dumplings), Zeli (Czech sauerkraut), Kolacky (little coffee cakes). (Tentative)
- **November:** Pictures for a new parish photo directory to be taken (the last one was in '12)
- **(TBD):** Pilgrimage to the EWTN Network complex in Alabama. We're working out the details now, but it should wind up being a 3-day sojourn by bus for our parishioners who would like to see and experience this vibrant and vital exercise of American Catholicism. As I've indicated, we have nothing planned, not even the dates for the pilgrimage, but most likely, it will be next spring. I'm reluctant to quote a price, but we'll try to keep it to around \$350.

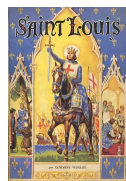

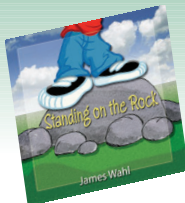
