THE HARVEY FLOOD...AND NOW IRMA!

Your response to the Harvey flood in Houston was, as I knew it would be, generous to a fault. But now we have another disaster of apocalyptic proportions in Florida! Archbishop Carlson has once again asked us to help. So, just like with Harvey, do the following if you want to help:

QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC

Many English words are derived from Latin bases and many of those Latin derivatives have distinctive prefixes and suffixes. The prefix “trans” is quite common. In Latin, it means “across”, and, when tacked onto the beginning of a word, usually makes that word mean that something is either changing from one thing into another, crossing over from one place to another, or it is being given from one to another. Whether it’s in its full form, “trans”, or an abbreviated one with the “n” dropping out, a lot of the words we use in the Church begin with that one prefix. See if you can identify the “trans” words in the Catholic Church:

1. When Jesus took Peter, James, and John up the mountain and showed His glory.
2. The doctrine that the substance of the bread & wine is changed to Jesus’ Body & Blood.
3. The Unwritten Word of God, equal to Scripture as a source of Public Revelation.
4. Notions, such as “unity”, or “truth”, which go beyond what the five senses perceive.

5. The heresy that teaches that the human soul is transmitted to the child by his parents.

6. The heresy that the Eucharist, while remaining bread and wine, is changed at Mass only to *signify* Jesus' Body & Blood.

7. In a cruciform church, it is the section, perpendicular to the nave, which forms the cross.

8. From the Latin, *traditor*, it literally means "one who hands over the books". This term was applied to those who not only abandoned the faith during persecutions, but also assisted the persecutors by surrendering the Church's books (and other goods) to them.

9. The task of interpreting a book from one language to another. (St. Jerome did this for the Bible.)

10. Any philosophy that gives great priority to experiences that are beyond the senses, usually developing into mysticism, such as the movement in New England in the 19th c.
