From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT DECEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION!

ZACH FLETCHER, ADIEU!

Roughly three years ago, a young man joined our maintenance staff in order to fill a vacancy created by the departure of our previous maintenance man. Little did any of us know at that time what a fine young man he was nor how much he would become a part of our lives here at St. Angela. That, of course, was Zach Fletcher (although I think most people just knew him as “Zach”) and in the time that he was with us, he really became a part of our parish. I am profoundly sad, therefore, to let you know that he is leaving us. He found a position that is much more suitable to his situation, and we simply cannot provide for him what he legitimately needs and deserves. I think you all know that he gave us his very best, and we will miss him terribly; young men of his caliber are quite rare! Please join me in wishing him all our best and praying for his happiness and success in his new job.

OUR MAINTENANCE NEEDS

Zach’s departure creates a hole in what had been the arrangement of our maintenance staff, and we’re dealing with creative ways to fulfill it. We probably don’t need a full-time replacement, so we’re not looking for one right now. The kind of services that we need would be strictly janitorial, i.e., mopping, vacuuming, emptying trash, spreading salt, riding a lawn mower, etc. It would not demand any skill in carpentry, plumbing or electrical work, although slinging a paint brush may be involved. The ideal candidate for such a job would be an able-bodied person, retired or semi-retired, who is looking for 12-20 hours a week of work for a little extra cash, but anyone who can do (and would like) the job, would be a worthy candidate. As I say, right now we’re weighing our options and trying to determine our needs, so I mention all this purely to create a data-base of what’s available to us, so if you (or anybody you know) would be interested, please let me know.

ADVENT VESPERS

We had a wonderful first night of vespers last Sunday and are doing it again this Sunday. So come all ye faithful, and invite the whole family to join you (and a few of the neighbors, as well)! It all starts at 7:00PM (and lasts about half an hour). What a great and traditional way to keep a holy Advent!

CONFESSIONS

Advent is the season for re-prioritizing and taking care of those things that have been put off. For many people, the sacrament of Confession is one of those things. For that reason, and especially because this is the season of repentance, we’re offering extra times for Confession. This week, it will be on Tuesday, Dec. 11, from 6:30-7:00PM (and the usual 4:00-4:45PM on Saturday).

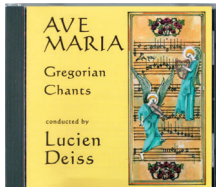
