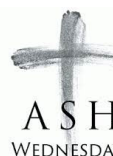

REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!

THE FURTHER CELEBRATION OF ETHNIC FOODS IN HONOR OF OUR SAINTS

Our celebration of the feast of St. Angela is over and what a blast it was! The food was tremendous and the turnout spectacular. A great time was had by all. Even though the holy season of fasting and not feasting will soon be upon us, there is still much to celebrate and good reason to gather the parish family at table together. For the next time, we're thinking of honoring two saints from diverse backgrounds whose feasts are back-to-back: St. Katherine Drexel of Philadelphia and St. Casimir of Poland (March 3rd & 4th, respectively). What would be served? Why the best that comes from Poland: *pierogi*, of course, and *kielbasa*, along with the various other sausages and fine meats purveyed at Piekutowski's. But what has Philadelphia to offer? If you ask, then you have never been to the City of Brotherly Love! They have Cheese Steaks and Hoagies, and the best pretzels you've ever eaten. And, even though it's Lent, for dessert we'll probably be able to come up with some *paczki*, and other sweets. (The full menu has yet to be determined.) Save the date: Saturday, March 3, served after the 5:00PM Mass until 8:00PM (and tell your friends!)

LENT, 2018

One week from this Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the 40 days of purification and sanctification. Now is the time to come up with a "game plan" for the holy season. The parish is going to do all we can to help you. We will do all the traditional things (Stations of the Cross on Fridays and extra Confession times), plus all the usual things (Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesday and daily Mass), but there will also be some extra things (like our Lenten Speaker Series on Friday evenings after the Stations). On Ash Wednesday we will have three Masses (6:30 & 8:00AM, and 7:00PM), and I will offer 8:00am Mass every Saturday morning all through Lent.

BRING OUT YOUR PALMS!

If you have any palms from last Palm Sunday, there's a receptacle in the vestibule to gather them for their ultimate fate, namely, to be burned to make the ashes of Ash Wednesday.

The CD's with the pictures from our recent pilgrimage to Fatima, etc., are now available (in the parish office, which is open 8-4, M-F)). First dibs on them goes to the pilgrims, but there will be others available for non-pilgrims, too.

ANSWERS: All of them were spoken by the same man, who sticks out like a sore thumb among all the saints named above, the stoic and pagan philosopher, G, Musonius Rufus. The significance of which is that our Catholic condemnation of the Culture of Death and its promotion of abortion, divorce, birth control, etc. is derided by the secular media as a "religious issue" (and a singularly Catholic scruple at that!), whereas one can arrive at all our conclusions through the exercise of rational thought independent of divine revelation, as our good friend and ally, Musonius Rufus (c. 20-101AD) proves. 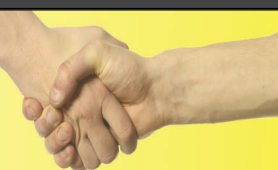
