## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT MARCH IS THE MONTH OF ST. JOSEPH!**

### **PASSIONTIDE**

Today begins the most somber period in the Catholic Church, for it is the holy time called *Passiontide*. During this time the holy season of Lent takes a dramatic turn and sharpens its focus distinctly on the sufferings of the Savior. We convey the grave tone of Passiontide through the draping of our statues and holy images with purple crepe. These are usually expressions of joy. How can we be joyful as we behold Our Lord hanging in agony on the Cross? The statues will remain covered until Easter time, when the joy of the Lord's Rising will dispel all sadness and the glory of His house will be revealed once more. Also, there will be special times for Confession in Lent's last two weeks (see the "Upcoming Events" article below for times).

### **THE FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH**

Don't forget that tomorrow (Monday, March 19) is the major feast of St. Joseph (he also has another one on May 1). Although it is a holy day of obligation of the Catholic Church, it is not observed as one here in the United States. Nonetheless, it is a huge feast and one so important that we suspend the usual Mass of Passiontide on that day to celebrate it. There will be special festivities both on that day and on the following weekend. All Catholics esteem and revere this singularly faithful man, but the Czechs and the Italians particularly have wonderful special traditions for celebrating his feast. Come and take part!

We have a brand new crop of altar servers, freshly trained and rarin' to go. They have been spending the last few Saturday mornings in church (giving up watching cartoons at home!) to learn how to serve Mass and will begin serving this weekend. ### **ALABAMA, HERE WE COME!**

It looks like our pilgrimage to the studios of EWTN is a go! We'll leave St. Angela early in the morning on our new Marian feast day (May 21) and return the evening of the 24<sup>th</sup>. For only \$300 per person, you'll get your bus transportation, hotel and breakfast. You will be responsible for your lunch, dinner, and any souvenirs/holy items you might want to purchase. Besides the EWTN shrine & studio, there will also be a stop at the mother-house of the Dominican Sisters of St. Cecilia in Nashville. There's room for 55 and non-parishioners are welcome (but priority will be given to our own parishioners). You can book your place now in the parish office (checks payable to St. Angela Merici).

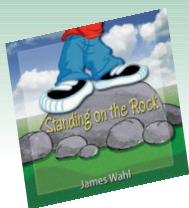
