## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT APRIL IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE HOLY EUCHARIST, AND MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!**

### **ST. JOSEPH THE WORKMAN**

This Monday, May 1 (May Day), is the Feast of St. Joseph Workman, and that makes it our ecclesiastical Labor Day. Consequently, there will be special devotions to St. Joseph on that day, with particular emphasis on prayers for those who are unemployed or underemployed. Since it falls on a Tuesday, the usual Perpetual Help Devotions will be replaced with devotions to St. Joseph both in the morning after Mass and in the evening at the conclusion of Adoration. Again, the prayers will be for those seeking employment.

### **NEXT STOP, GERMANY**

Our cycle of ethno-hagiographical dinners begins again June right back where we started, with a special evening of German culture and cuisine. We'll let you know the *spiesearte* (menu) and date later.

### **RISEN JESUS STATUE**

This will be the last weekend for the Empty Tomb and Risen Christ statue in our church for this year. With the May Day celebration of St. Joseph the Workman, that shrine area will be restored to the foster father of the Savior. I did, however, want to put in place the memorial plaque for those in whose memory the statue was donated. I ask you, therefore, to take a look at that plaque and, if you were a donor, to make sure we got the names right. If you're not a donor, please look, anyway, and, in your Catholic magnanimity, say a prayer for those whose names are subscribed thereon!

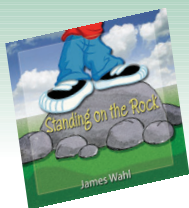
