## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

### **REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!**

#### **PENTECOST**

As you see our parish church boldly decorated to remind us of the presence of the Holy Spirit this Pentecost and showing us how all-pervasive is His power, we also remember that this dramatic first pouring forth of the breath of God's Spirit is the very birth day and origin of the Church. Consequently, it is quite fitting that today four of our young parishioners are going to receive the sacrament of Confirmation at the 9:30 Mass. They are: Noah and Nicholas DOBBS, Brianna HUNT, and Hayley MARTIN. Our congratulations to them and to their families. We expect great things from them because of the powerful gift they are being given!

#### **RELIGIOUS GOODS FROM BELARUS**

This weekend we are going to be visited by religious sisters from the Diocese of Minsk in Belarus. They are from the Convent of St. Elisabeth, and they work with sick children in boarding homes and those who suffer from chemical addictions. They are here to purvey the religious items that they have made in order to support their work. Please stop by the lunch room to welcome them and, if you can, lend your support.

#### **FOR WHOM THE BELL TOLLS...**

You probably noticed that our church bells haven't been ringing, or that they actually *have* been ringing, but only inside church (and not projecting from our bell tower). As you know, the bells hanging in our campanile are just for show, they are incapable of ringing. The sound of ringing bells that issues forth from the tower is produced by an electronic system that is now about 25 years old and well past its peak (which is why it's not working well). As it is with all old electronics, it's out-of-date, worthless, and not cost-effective to repair. That's why we're getting a new system, one that is state-of-the-art and capable of doing a lot more. The new system will chime the angelus and the Mass call, but it will also tone the hours, toll for funerals, and play liturgically-appropriate hymns throughout the day (and several other things as well!). Talk about all the bells and whistles! (Actually, no whistles; just the bells.) An anonymous family of our parish is picking up the cost. Our thanks to them!

#### **CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION**

Don't forget the great annual Florissant Corpus Christi Procession. It's a tradition that started in the 19<sup>th</sup> century and has been revived in our time. It began with the French first settlers of Florissant (who founded St. Ferdinand) getting together with the later-arriving German immigrants (who founded Sacred Heart) in a great show of Catholic solidarity in the Sacrament of our unity. It begins at Sacred Heart on Sunday, June 3, at 1:00PM and proceeds down Rue St. Francois (pausing for Benediction along the way) to the old St. Ferdinand Shrine for the final Benediction. Refreshments and food will be served at the conclusion in the park around St. Ferdinand. Shuttle transportation will be provided from St. Ferdinand back to Sacred Heart.
