THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Every year on the two Sundays following Pentecost, the Church bids us contemplate her two greatest mysteries, namely, the Unity and Trinity of God, and the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. Today we contemplate the first one on this glorious Trinity Sunday.

IN MEMORY OF ALL FALLEN HEROES

Tomorrow (Monday), is the annual commemoration of those who, in President Lincoln's immortal words at Gettysburg, gave the last full measure of devotion. Let us honor them and, at the same time, pray for them. As is usual for our parish on national holidays, there will be one Mass at 9:00AM. Taking part in it is the least we can do for those who gave their all for us!

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

Don't forget the great annual Florissant Corpus Christi Procession. It's a tradition that started in the 19th century and has been revived in our time. It began with the first French settlers of Florissant (who founded St. Ferdinand) getting together with the later-arriving German immigrants (who founded Sacred Heart) in a great show of Catholic solidarity in the Sacrament of our unity. It begins at Sacred Heart next Sunday, June 3, at 1:00PM and proceeds down Rue St. Francois (pausing for Benediction along the way) to the old St. Ferdinand Shrine for the final Benediction. Refreshments and food will be served at the conclusion in the park around St. Ferdinand. Shuttle transportation will be provided from St. Ferdinand back to Sacred Heart. (Special invite to all who made their First Communion this year!)

GERMAN FOOD NIGHT

Every year, it seems like everybody puts on something green on March 17 and eats a supposed Irish meal consisting of corned beef and cabbage. Now, I *like* corned beef and cabbage, but I really doubt that it's authentically Irish. Sadly, June 5 is the feast of the patron saint of the Germans, the holy St. Boniface, but nobody seems to celebrate it, even though the Germans are still the number one ethnic group in the USA. That was the case until now! St. Angela's is hosting its second annual German Food Night on Tuesday, June 5, from 4:30 to 7:00PM in the lunchroom and on the surrounding lawn. That Meister Chef, Herr Donald Krause, is once again supplying a bill of fare that is as German as Wolfgang Puck, along with real German Bier, tons of real German music, and genuine Teutonic *gemuetlichkeit*. 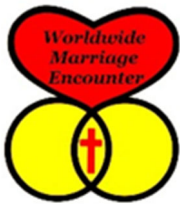

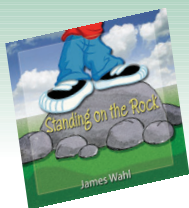
