From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JULY IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS!

OUR NEW FLOOR

As I write this, the workmen are still installing the new sanctuary floor in church, but they've promised me faithfully that we would be out of the catacombs (i.e., the lunchroom) this weekend and back in church. I can't wait to see the finished product myself and then to be able to show it off to you. So far, it looks just beautiful, truly befitting the house of the Almighty. Our staunch and sturdy staff and parishioners have been taking photos and videos of the installation; I hope to have a public showing of the resulting video when all is done.

INDEPENDENCE DAY

We Americans reckon the Fourth of July, 1776, as the day of our national independence from Great Britain (even though it wasn't until seven years later on September 3, 1783 that England recognized our independence with the signing of the Treaty of Paris). President Lincoln considered the Fourth of July to be the birth day of our great republic, and said so in his famous speech at Gettysburg, reminding the people at that time and place (1863) that the start of our nation was some "four score and seven" years previous. We will celebrate our national independence on this coming July 4, while, at the same time, honoring our St. Angela tradition of having only one Mass that day, at 9:00AM. Let's gather together as Catholic patriots and thank God for the blessings of this wonderful land on the 242nd anniversary of her founding!

PARISH SANCTIFICATION

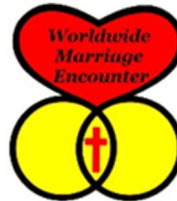

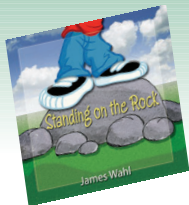

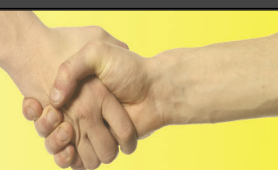
