## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT JULY IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS!**

### **OUR SEPTEMBER OKTOBERFEST**

Well, this is really turning into quite the extravaganza! Our committee and crew keep coming up with more and more wonderful stuff and activities. Set the date: September 28 (Friday). It's going to be a great evening with great German food, beer, & music, and a *whole lot* more! You'll never forgive yourself if you miss it! I can't wait!

### **VIDEO SERIES ON THE PROTESTANT REVOLT**

Our Adult Faith Formation Committee is presenting a magnificent video presentation series on the Protestant Revolt (let's not call it reformation because it wasn't that at all; it destroyed much more than it reformed). It is timed, more or less, with the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Luther's posting of his thesis in Wittenberg in 1517, which is usually acknowledged to be the foundational act of the movement. It prompted the Church to institute *authentic* reforms, but, ultimately, wound up amputating several members from the Body of Christ with its promotion of bad ideas. The series is shown each Tuesday (see below for the dates) after the P. H. Devotions in the lunchroom. This Tuesday's chapter is: "St. Thomas More and the Age of the Author".

### **COME JOIN US FOR MORNING PRAYER**

Even before I arrived here, our parish has had the tradition of gathering every morning to pray the Divine Office (i.e., the *breviary*, or *liturgical hours* of the Catholic Church). This constitutes the Church's official, solemn Morning and Evening Prayer. Typically, it's prayed by all priests and religious, but lay people can pray it, too, and many of ours do on a daily basis. It's a bit complicated and requires a tutor to lead you through it until you have the hang of it yourself, but we have copies of the books for you and people who would be more than glad to assist you. We pray it Monday through Friday (holidays excluded) at 7:40AM and again on Sundays at 9:00AM. It's a beautiful way to connect with the rhythms of the Church's seasonal liturgy, and, through that, to God Himself. Come join us!

### **ST. VINCENT de PAUL SOCIETY SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT (JANUARY THRU JUNE 2018)**

In an effort to be good stewards of the contributions made to the SVDP Society, we continue to make home visits in teams of two Vincentians to assess the needs of our clients.

- \* From January 1 to June 30, our members made 103 home visits. In addition to the home visits, many contacts are made by phone. There were 345 persons helped by single or multiple visits to a household.
- \* There were 286 Vincentian hours involved in those home visits plus the many phone hours required.
- \* Assistance was given to 46 families to avoid Spire disconnection.
- \* Assistance was given to 50 families to avoid Ameren disconnection.
- \* Assistance was given to 5 families to avoid MO-AM water disconnection.
- \* Through the Beds for Neighbors program we were able to get 16 beds for families.
- \* We were able to help 1 family purchase a car through the Car Program and we helped 3 families avoid eviction through the Bridges Fund of the Main Council Office.
- \* In addition to utility assistance, we were able to give people SVDP Thrift Store vouchers to help with clothing & household items. We were able to get Thrift Store Vouchers because of your response when the SVDP truck was at St. Angela's in April.
- \* We continue to be one of the largest contributors to the TEAM food pantry with our monthly Food Drives which also allows us sometimes to take food packages directly to our clients.

In the first six months of this year we disbursed \$23,742 that had been donated by the generous parishioners at St. Angela's including the Ladies Club April Food Truck event. Other sources of funds are the Main Council Office, the North District SVDP Society & the Rise-n-Shine Fund Raiser. We have also been blessed this year to have support from other archdiocesan SVDP conferences, Holy Infant, St. Francis of Assisi & Holy Redeemer.

We are very grateful to the parishioners at St. Angela Merici for their financial contributions, the Food Drive donations, the Spring clothing & household truck collection. We appreciate your support in this ministry.

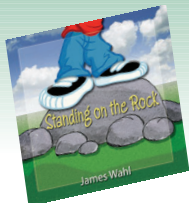

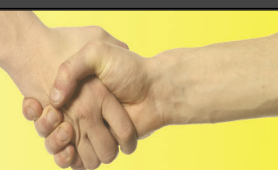
