## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!**

### **THE SIXTH CHAPTER OF JOHN; THE REAL PRESENCE**

Our reading from the sixth chapter of St. John's Gospel continues this Sunday, as does my speaking on the subject contained therein, namely, Jesus' famous Discourse on the Bread of Life. And, again, I will base my lesson on a specific title of the consecrated bread and wine of the Mass. This week I will speak of it as the Real Presence of Christ, how He is truly and most effectively found (as the disciples on the Road to Emmaus discovered) in the Breaking of the Bread. On the next two Sundays the topic will be: the Blessed Sacrament (and Holy Communion), and Transubstantiation. I hope it will be fruitful for all.

### **FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF OUR LADY**

The Feast of our Lady's Assumption falls on a Wednesday this year (Aug. 15), and so it is a holy day of obligation. I will try to make the Masses of that feast as accessible as possible by having the usual 8:00AM Mass on Aug. 15, and evening Mass on the evening before and on the day itself. (The Tuesday evening Mass at 7:00 will preclude the usual P. H. Devotions that night.)

### **IN CONCERT: DANIEL KUEHLER**

Don't forget that this afternoon (Aug. 12), Maestro Danny Kuehler returns to perform for us a recital on the grand piano at 2:00PM in the lunchroom. All are welcome, all is free (but a hat will be passed!), snacks provided.

### **THE STORY OF OUR TERRAZZO FLOOR**

After the 7:00PM Mass this Wednesday, there will be a showing of a video on the fabrication of the new terrazzo floor in our sanctuary. It was masterfully put together by that wizard of all things I.T., our staunch and true parishioner, Jude Pauli, from pictures taken by various parishioners, capturing all the different phases of its construction. The process is ancient and requires a great deal of hand-workmanship, starting with the surface preparation, and then continuing with the layout of the pattern, the mixing of the elements, and then the grinding, polishing, and sealing. It's quite a thing to behold! I think you'll be intrigued by it, and it only runs about 13 minutes.

### **"FATHER, WHO TAKES CARE OF YOUR GARDENS?"**

We had many visitors come to our parish last Sunday for the Mass for God the Father and that's the question I was asked *numerous* times. I very dutifully put credit where it was due, and informed them all of our green-thumbed gardeners, who take their residence in the "Valley of the Flowers" quite seriously (and personally!). Our reputation as "Shaw's Garden North" is safe and expanding!

### **RCIA CLASS OF 2019**

It's not too soon to start thinking ahead to this fall and our convert class for next Easter. If you (or anyone you know) is thinking about becoming Catholic, then please let me know about it. This is something that requires a great deal of prayerful consideration. If I can even answer any questions, I'll be happy to do so.

### **QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC**

Since the feast of Our Lady's Assumption is this Wednesday, I'll make this quiz on that subject and, at the same time, keep it simple:

1. When was the Church's teaching on the Assumption declared a *dogma* (i.e., as a fact of history and officially part of the Deposit of the Faith from the time of the Apostles until now) of the Catholic Church?

**ANSWERS:** 1. 1950 (as an exercise of Papal Infallibility, Pope Pius XII surveyed all the bishops of the world with the questions: what do you believe about Our Lady's Assumption and have you always believed this? In response, he learned that the whole Catholic world did believe what we now profess, and so he confirmed it with the solemn, *ex cathedra* decree)

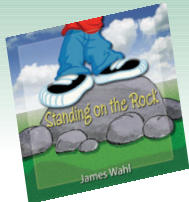
