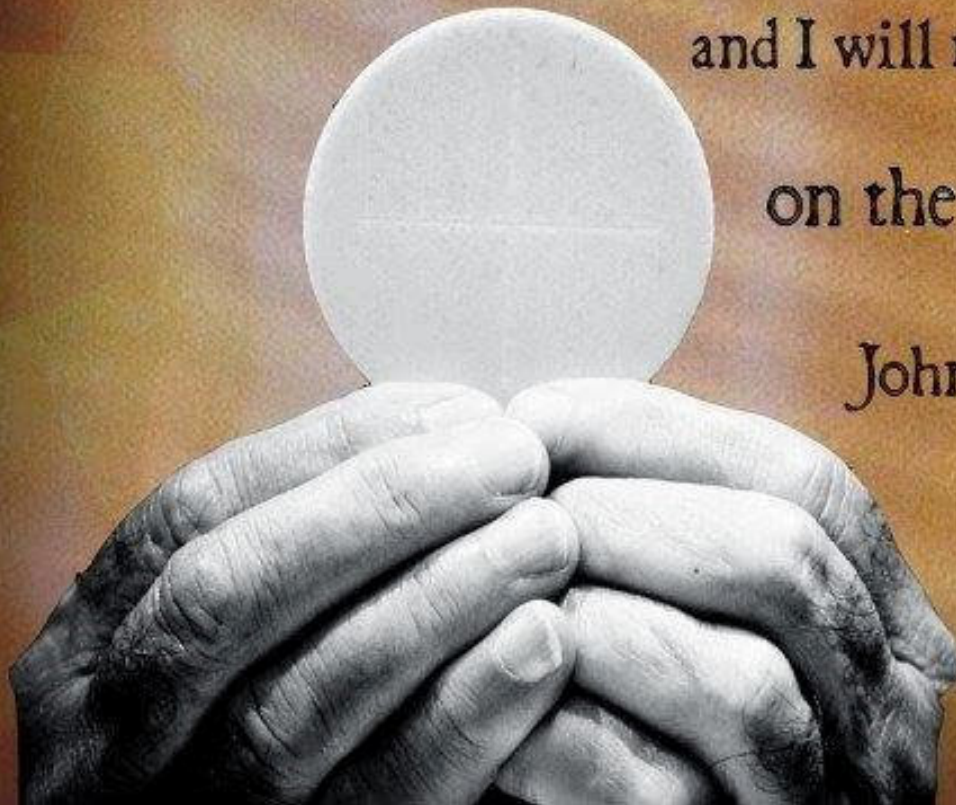

## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!**

### **THE SIXTH CHAPTER OF JOHN; THE BLESSED SACRAMENT**

Continuing the readings from the sixth chapter of John this week, we see how Jesus faces controversy from the incredulous crowds who just can't see how Jesus can give them His Body and Blood to consume as Bread for eternal Life. I will also continue to speak of the bread and wine of Mass, this time on its title as the "Blessed Sacrament" (next week will be on "Holy Communion").

### **CATECHISM CLASS RESUMES!**

For the past four years now, I have been conducting an ongoing study of the Catechism of the Catholic Church for the benefit of any and all who wish to take part in it. It's a very informal gathering of Catholics (and occasionally a non-Catholic or two), folks who are all believers seeking to know the Lord better. Everybody is welcome and all are invited to take part. As I say, it's very informal. We talk about whatever people want to talk about and, when the questions cease or the discussion dies down, we go back to the text of the Catechism itself and resume where we left off previously (this usually stirs up further conversation and discussion). All in all, it's a good evening. It takes place on the first and third Tuesdays of each month (unless otherwise indicated) after the 7:00PM Perpetual Help Devotions in the Parish Meeting Room (located next to my office and accessible through the choir area of church). The 2018-2019 term commences on September 4 (the day after Labor Day). Plan on taking part, if you can. (Please be clear that this is something different from the classes for converts, the RCIA.)

### **RCIA CLASS OF 2019**

Speaking of converts, it's not too soon to start thinking ahead to this fall and our convert class for next Easter. If you (or anyone you know) is thinking about becoming Catholic, then please let me know about it. This is something that requires a great deal of prayerful consideration. If I can ever answer any questions, I'll be happy to do so.

Naumann (Kansas City, KS), and Cardinal Dolan (New York, NY)* 3. *1893* 4. *The old Visitation Academy building on 19<sup>th</sup> & Cass, the building now the "Rigali Center" on Abp. May Dr., and the current "Kenrick/Glennon" site on Glennon Dr.* 5. *Three: DuBourg, Rosati-Kain (named for two bishops!), and Cardinal Ritter Prep (there had been a "Kenrick High School" many years ago, but now long closed)* 6. *St. Genevieve (Valle) and St. Vincent's in Perryville* 7. *You could name: St. Mark's, St. Alphonsus, St. John the Baptist (south St. Louis),*

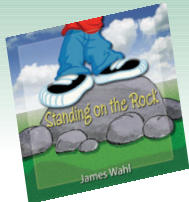
