



## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!**

### **THE SIXTH CHAPTER OF JOHN; HOLY COMMUNION**

This Sunday, we will hear the final installment of the Gospel readings from the sixth chapter of John, Jesus' great discourse on the Bread of Life. I will speak of the bread and wine at Mass as the "Holy Communion", why we call it that and all that it means.

### **THE BUDGET**

This issue of the bulletin contains the annual financial report of the parish. As you can see, the parish is quite solvent, and will be for the well-foreseeable future. This is because of your kindness and loving support of the parish, which expresses itself in so many diverse ways. I know that a lot of people were concerned about the gap between the reported target amount of the weekly collection and what we actually took in, but those numbers were based on the days when we had a school (we didn't know at the time how else to project costs) and didn't factor in the "on-line" contributions. One thing we all need to keep in mind, though, is that even though our school is closed, we still have over 30 students in other Catholic schools whose tuition we are obliged to supplement, and we still have some fixed costs with our school building. These include such costs as the insurance on the building and its alarm system (which haven't gone down at all), and utilities and maintenance (which have come down quite a bit). Additionally, the Archdiocese still taxes us to support the Archdiocesan School Office. All in all, all is well (but we *do* depend upon your continued loving support, for which we are all very grateful!).

### **"FOR A HOLE IN YOUR ROOF OR A WHOLE NEW ROOF"**

So goes the familiar radio commercial jingle for a local roofing company. Well, sadly, it somewhat pertains to our church roof, which is, by now, many years old. This past week we had a brief, but driving, rainstorm and it revealed a leak in our roof up in the sanctuary. As of this writing, we're checking it out and don't know the extent of the problem, but I want to keep you abreast of it, because it could be a costly repair (somewhere in the \$40,000 range).

### **"LET THE LITTLE CHILDREN COME TO ME"**

For the benefit of those who have small children, our parish will very soon be offering a Sunday School service at the 9:30AM Mass. One of our parishioners, who runs the day care at Delmar Gardens, has graciously volunteered to manage it for us. The way it will work is this: the parents drop the kids off at the old pre-school classroom at the start of Mass and pick them up at the end. While they're there, the kids will learn lessons that pertain to what their parents are absorbing in church. We should be starting very soon.

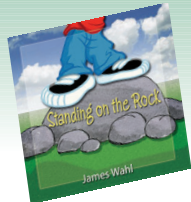
