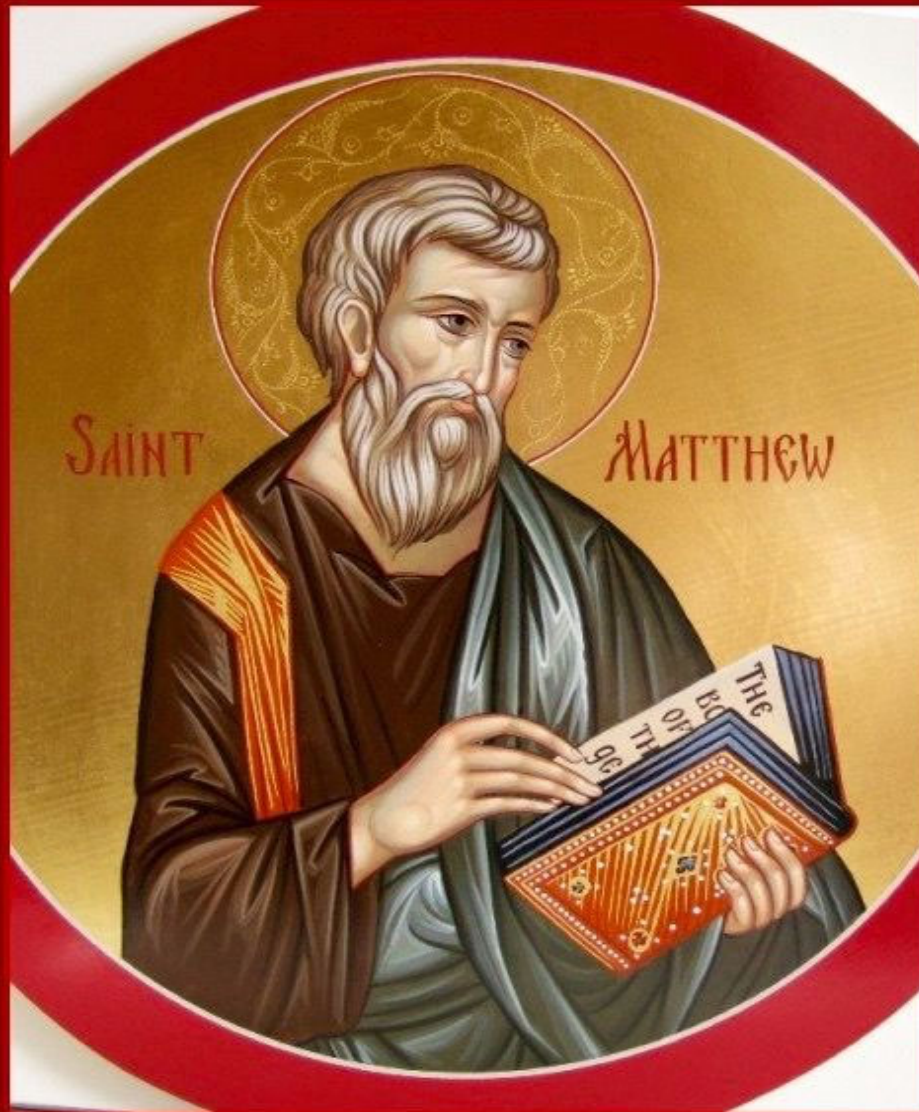

Next weekend, I will be out of town at a Catholic convention in Kansas City. In my absence, Fr. Jerry Beat from UNBOUND will offer all the Masses and make an appeal. "Unbound" is an organization that was founded by lay people to evangelize and care for the poor. In their case, that means the poorest of the poor around the world. Please be generous!

This is shaping up to be quite the swell affair! Please invite your kids and grandkids to come; all of you will have a wonderful time!

SAYING "NO" TO CRACK

In case you haven't noticed, our crack (or, I should say, *anti*-crack maintenance staff) has hunted down, cleaned out, and filled every crack they could find on our parish parking lot. 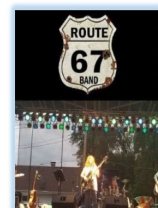

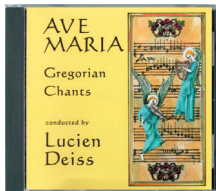

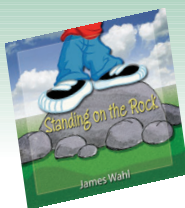
