Begun by King Louis IX, our Archdiocesan patron saint, in France in the 1300s, the Red Mass enjoys a long tradition in our country.

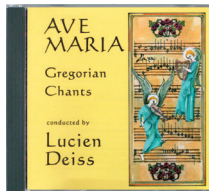

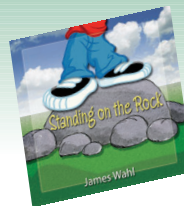
