From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT DECEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION AND JANUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY CHILDHOOD OF JESUS!

THE FEAST OF THE HOLY FAMILY

Every year, the Sunday between Christmas and New Year's is designated to be the Feast of the Holy Family, by which the Church asks us to contemplate, appreciate, and savor the blessings of family life. The basic concept is that every human family should be patterned after the blessed little community that existed in Nazareth in the home of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. This has never been more necessary, for we are seeing an unprecedented assault on the family in our highly secularized and anti-God society. In former days, our culture was burdened by the presence of highly vocal atheists; now we are plagued with a horde of ultra-obnoxious *anti*-theists (just look at the "Women's March" that is held in DC right after the Pro-Life March every year). This new breed makes you yearn for the days when God's enemies merely refused to acknowledge His existence. The institution of the family is the building block of every sane community and civilization that is worthy of the name. It is of divine origin and needs to be respected and celebrated as such, and that is exactly what today's feast is all about.

THE DIVINE MATERNITY OF Mary

Don't forget the holy day of obligation this Wednesday, the Divine Maternity of Mary. Masses will be at 5:00PM on Tuesday (with the Pro-Life New Year's dinner to follow) and at 8:00 & 10:00AM on Wednesday.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

New Year's Eve falls on this coming Tuesday, and as such, we *will* have Adoration that day, but only until noon. For future reference, if there's significantly bad weather on a Tuesday, we will not expose the Blessed Sacrament throughout the day, because many will not show (and rightly so) and we can only *expose* the Eucharist if someone is there to adore it. Nonetheless, if you are able to make it to church on such a day and would like to spend time with the Lord, please do come, knock on the office door, and we'll let you into church. The Blessed Sacrament will not be exposed, but the Lord will still be there, present in the tabernacle for you to adore Him.

NEWS YOU MIGHT HAVE MISSED

- Pew Research has recently revealed that America has the highest percentage of children being raised in single-parent homes (23%), followed by the U.K. (21%) and Russia (18%). Compare that with 3% in China. The great historian of culture, Will Durant, pointed out that the vast majority of the great civilizations of history rotted and collapsed from within, and that the beginning of the end came when they started playing fast and loose with the definition of the family.

- The average Sunday sermon in America (also according to Pew) lasts 37 minutes, but the breakdown is as follows: "black protestant" - 54 minutes, "mainline protestant" - 25 minutes, Catholic - 14 minutes. It should be pointed out that there is no altar in Protestant worship (meaning that their clergy are not priests who offer sacrifice, but rather "ministers" of the word of God, and so their services are restricted to the proclamation of the word and the singing of hymns). That being the case, one would expect their sermons to last longer. Indeed, Protestant clergy are hired, fired, and paid according to their ability to deliver a sockdoligizing sermon.

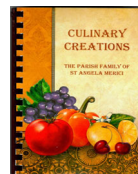

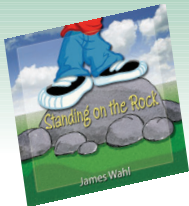
