## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT DECEMBER IS THE MONTH OF MARY'S IMMACULATE CONCEPTION!**

### **TO HONOR HER AS PATRONESS OF THE UNITED STATES**

The event which gives definition to the official Catholic piety of this month, namely, the Immaculate Conception, is being celebrated tomorrow, Monday Dec. 9. Of course, it normally would be celebrated on Dec. 8, but that's the Second Sunday of Advent, and that feast takes precedence even over one as large as Our Lady's sinless origins. That does not mean, however, that her feast will go unobserved, because every time this happens, the observance of the feast is shifted to the next day, as it is this year. This is a feast that every American Catholic should be pleased to honor, inasmuch as in 1846 the bishops of the U.S. named Mary, under the title of "Immaculate Conception", to be the patroness of the United States. The obligation to attend Mass, however, does not transfer over to Monday. Still and all, we will have Mass at 8:00AM and I think you would be happy to be able to attend!

### **TO HONOR HER AS EMPRESS OF THE AMERICAS**

This Thursday, Dec. 12, the Church commemorates the signal event in human history when the Mother of God condescended to appear to St. Juan Diego and caused a flood of miraculous events, the most significant of which was the mass conversions to the faith among the indigenous peoples of Central and South America. Of course we are offering Mass at 8:00AM to celebrate the feast, but we are also having our big Mexican Food Night, replete with piñatas and appropriate music. Come one, come all! 4:30 to 7:00PM in the gym.

### **VESPERS**

We will again have Vespers for the Sunday of Advent again this evening at 7:00 in church. What a great way to prepare for the Birth of the Messiah!

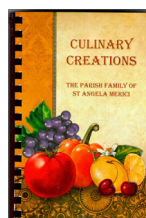
### PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

**REQUIREMENTS** For every employee, Clergy and volunteer The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. 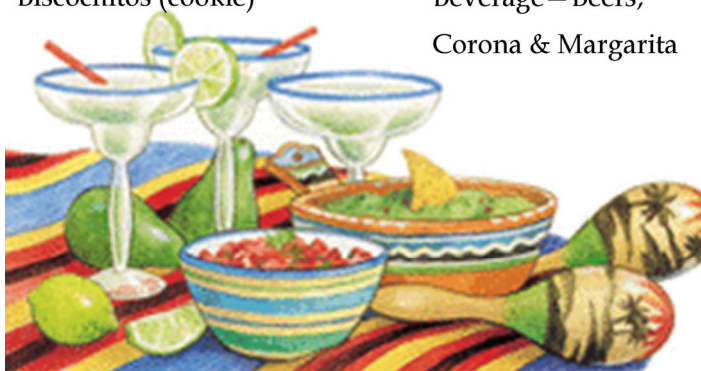

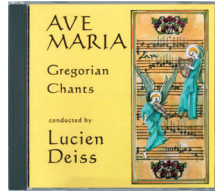

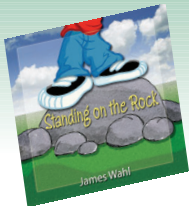
