From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!

SAD NEWS

This past Monday morning at 1:00, someone broke into our parish offices. Nothing was stolen, disturbed, or damaged (except the two frames of the doors that were kicked in); apparently, when the burglar alarm sounded, the intruder freaked out and exited the scene. As best we can tell, he entered our buildings through the exit door which is accessed through the walkway just to the left of the Blessed Mother shrine; it had not closed all the way. Most likely, he had walked the perimeter of our buildings on the outside, looking for an unlocked door, and happened to hit pay dirt. He made his way through church into the Meeting Room and proceeded to kick in the two doors to my office. The police arrived quickly and handled the situation most professionally. Whenever the alarm sounds, Stanley Security (our alarm company) calls me along with the police and so I walked up to the offices as well, arriving at the same time as the police. The “perp” was not to be found. We do have a *very* good idea of who it is, but, lacking hard evidence, we can’t take much further action against him. He does live in our neighborhood and was formerly fitted for a GPS ankle-bracelet because of his long and well-established pattern of breaking and entering. We are watching him closely.

We do need your assistance in these ways: 1) if your organization is using the buildings for any kind of function, please check and make sure all the exit doors are **LOCKED AND FULLY SHUT** when you leave, 2) if someone enters the building who obviously does not belong here (i.e., he’s not a member of your organization, or he’s panhandling, or he’s heading off into a part of the building where he doesn’t belong, etc.) *immediately* call the police...our suspect has been warned to stay off our property, so his very presence constitutes a violation, 3) be vigilant and keep your wits about you, especially if you’re handling money.

So far, this has stacked up to be the “Year of the Weather”. Many of you, wisely, opted not to risk life and limb on the ice last Sunday and did not make it for Mass. Though we’re glad you kept safe, we didn’t get your contribution, which, frankly, we need. And so I ask you again to make it up at your earliest convenience.

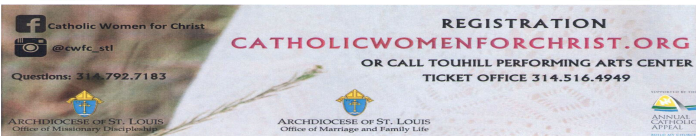

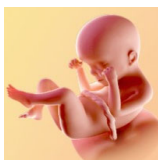

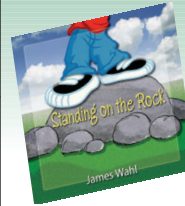
