## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT MARCH IS THE MONTH OF ST. JOSEPH!**

### **THE FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT**

Every year, the Gospel of Lent's first Sunday is always the same: the story of how, immediately following His Baptism by John, Jesus went forth into the wilderness for forty days, to fast, pray, and withstand the temptations and trials of the Evil One. The reason for that is clear: it is the very pattern of our annual Lenten forty-day retreat. And our purpose, too, is similar: preparation. The Lord's fast was a preparation for His public life; our fast is preparation for the renewal of our baptismal promises at Easter time (and for our catechumens to receive the Sacraments of Initiation [i.e., Baptism, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist]). While there are certain things that we Catholics all do together (e.g., fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and abstaining from meat on all of Lent's Fridays), each one of us, on our own, chooses to embrace some kind of penance. It could be something negative (like abstaining from sweets or snacks) or positive (such as attending daily Mass or almsgiving). In any case, it's done with the attitude of renewal and spiritual growth (but bodily diminution would probably be a welcome side-effect for most of us!). Lent began with the vivid reminder of our mortality; may it end at Easter with the brilliant awareness of future resurrection and glory!

### **KEEPING A ROOF OVER OUR HEADS**

I've only been here five years, so all I knew for certain about the roof of our church is that it is at least that old. Little did any of us know that the roof is actually much older. In fact, it's so far past warranty that we can claim to have come out well ahead on whatever it was that we paid for that roof at its installation. Whereas we did get a great deal on the current roof, it also means that that roof needs replacement. We've been holding it together with "wattle and daub" (as the Brits say) and have found some interesting detritus up there, ranging from bullets to birds' nests, but now it has to be refreshed. We're starting to accept bids on the roof work (which will also include some minor shingle work on the gym), and anticipate that it will cost in the \$20-30,000 range. The work will be done this spring or summer and we will take up a special collection to try to defray its costs. More later.

### **SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM**

Since I announced that we're going to install security cameras on our property, some of our faithful parishioners have stepped up to help finance it. We are most grateful to them.

### **FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH**

The big feast of holy Joseph falls on March 19, which is a week from this Tuesday. It is, of course, a very big festival of the Catholic Church and it gives this month its dedication in our Catholic piety. Next weekend, we will be offering the traditional St. Joseph bread, in honor of the "breadwinner" of the Holy Family. This will be the classic *Italian* St. Joseph bread, which is the best-tasting bread you will ever eat at any point of your earthly existence, and is second only to the Holy Eucharist itself. The custom is that it is to be offered or free, but the recipients are asked to make a donation for it to charity. In our case, the proceeds will feed the poor of the Vincent de Paul Society.
