From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT MARCH IS THE MONTH OF ST. JOSEPH!

THE THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Today marks Lent's Third Sunday, and brings us deeper still into the holy mysteries whose fullness will be celebrated in another month or so. In today's Gospel lesson, Jesus tells the parable of the Fig Tree Planted in the Vineyard. We, of course, are that tree. God gives us every chance in the world to produce the fruit He demands of us, viz., humility and holiness, and also all the material to make it happen. If we don't produce that fruit, it's our fault, not His. And once we've squandered every opportunity, there will come a day of reckoning. The lesson couldn't be clearer: don't waste the few hours of daylight that we have to work in. They will not be replaced and once they're gone, they're gone *forever*.

DEMONSTRATION OF MASS

Every year, I give our catechumens a live demonstration of Mass in order to help them understand exactly what takes place at Mass, why it's done, what it means, and what its effects are. I also invite the whole parish, including Catholics of long standing, to come and take part, too. It will take place this year tomorrow, Monday March 25, at 7:00PM in church. It lasts about 75 minutes.

FEAST OF THE ANNUNCIATION

Tomorrow (Monday, March 25) is the feast of the greatest news event in history: the Annunciation. Consequently, we will take time out of our usual Lenten observance to celebrate this great feast with all due solemnity and style. Mass will be at 8:00AM.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

Save the date: June 23, 2019 is the annual Florissant Corpus Christi Procession, but this year there will be a difference, namely, it will take place in the relative cool of the evening! Plan on it!

UNPLANNED

CONFESSION TIMES

Lent and the efficacious sacrament of Penance go perfectly together, and the special times for Confession start this week. You should all have received my annual Lent/Easter letter by now, so please note that I will be hearing Confessions this Tuesday (March 26) from 11:30-12:00noon.

IT HAPPENS EVERY SPRING

Yes, that could be said about the baseball season, but in this case, I'm talking about all the truly wretched and misleading stories, documentaries, specials, etc. about Jesus that appear on TV this time of year, usually on the cable stations.
