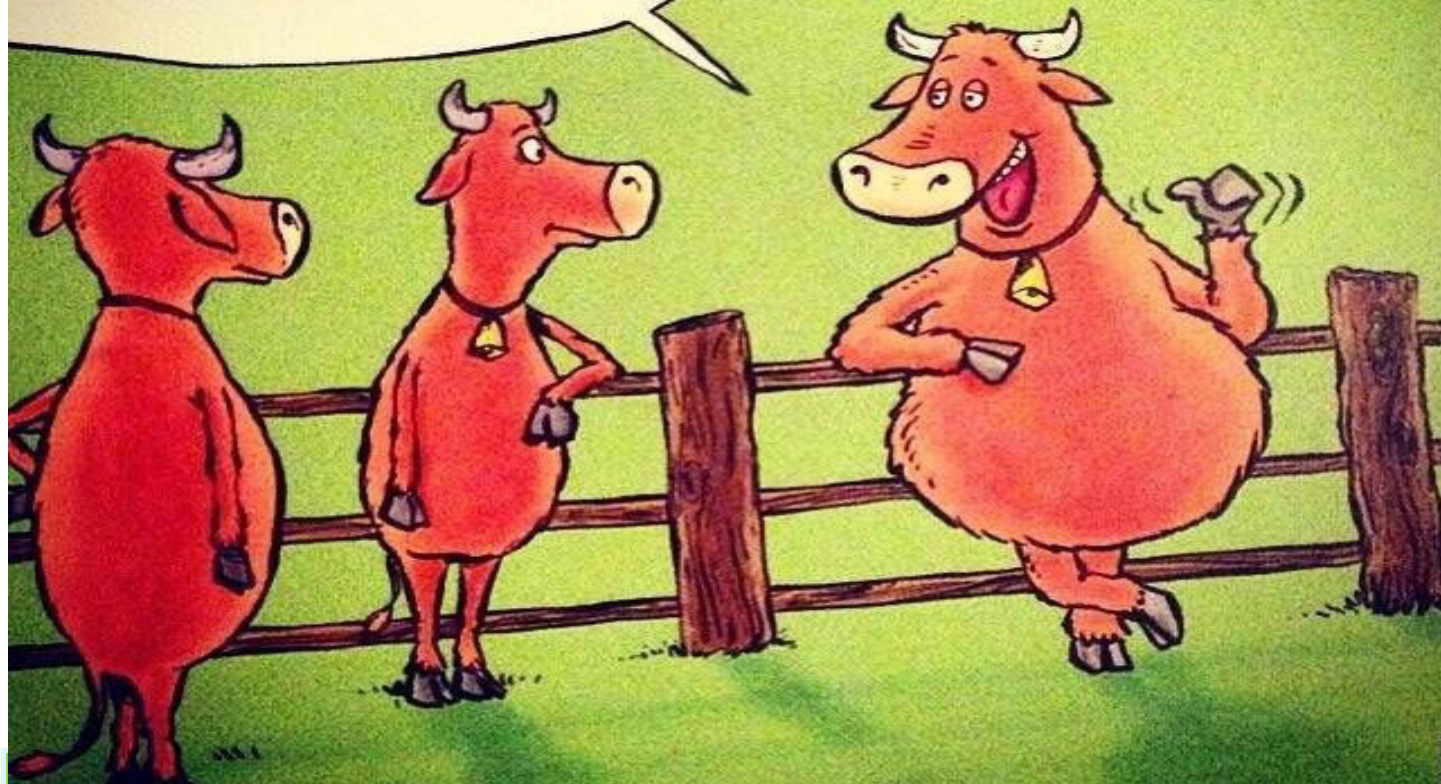

## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT MARCH IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE HOLY EUCHARIST!**

### **LAETARE, HIEROSOLYME!**

Last Friday was the mid-point of Lent, meaning that we are now, officially, more than half-way through this holy season of penance and charity. That being the case, it's time for a bit of rejoicing, modified though it may be by the awareness of the three weeks of Lent that remain! The Church expresses this attenuated bliss by wearing the liturgical color *rose*, which is only worn today and on the Third Sunday of Advent. Consequently, this Sunday has its own nickname: *Laetare Sunday*, drawn from the first word of the Entrance Antiphon (in Latin): *Laetare!* (Rejoice!) Being a blend of the liturgical colors white (rejoicing) and purple (penance and sorrow), rose perfectly expresses the mood of the day. So rejoice, Jerusalem (and St. Angela Parish, too), but not too much!

### **CHURCH TOUR**

Every year, I give our catechumens a live demonstration of Mass in order to help them understand exactly what takes place at Mass, why it's done, what it means, and what its effects are. I also invite the whole parish, including Catholics of long standing, to come and take part, too. It will take place this year tomorrow, Monday April 1st, at 4:00PM in church. It lasts about 75 minutes.

### **A SIMPLE LENTEN SUPPER**

Our parish is going to serve a "Simple Lenten Supper" on the Friday before Palm Sunday (April 12). It will be, immediately, a preparation for the Stations of the Cross and guest speaker that evening, but it will also help us get ready for the great events of Holy Week. We will serve a variety of delicious (but meatless) soups, gourmet Italian bread (without dessert), and heaping portions of parish sociability. There will be no charge for it, but a basket for donations to the Vincent de Paul Society will be on the table. Dinner will be served in our lunchroom from 5:30-7:00PM.

### **CONFESSION TIMES**

Lent and the efficacious sacrament of Penance go perfectly together, and the special times for Confession start this week. You should all have received my annual Lent/Easter letter by now, so please note that I will be hearing Confessions this Tuesday (April 2) from 11:30-12:00noon.

### **QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC**

There are certain mystical phenomena that are associated with our saints. These phenomena have an external manifestation that, frankly, defies the natural laws and deifies scientific explanation. Even so, there is more than ample proof that these holy men and women actually were given these gifts. Most saints have none of them, some have one, but there is a tiny number who exhibited more than one in their lifetime on earth. 7. The **POWER TO HEAL**

9. **INCORRUPTIBILITY** (i.e., their corpse does not decompose without any attempt to preserve it by natural means, e.g., freezing, embalming, etc.)

### LENTEN SPEAKER FOR, April 5th



Please join us Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup> after Stations of the Cross for a presentation by Fr. Christopher Collins, SJ. After attending Jesuit schools in Phoenix and Dallas, Fr. Collins took part in a service trip in El Salvador before his freshman year of college, discovering a love for service, community and faith. He fostered that interest by taking philosophy and theology classes, gaining an understanding of the intellectual elements of the Catholic faith. As a Jesuit, he served the Lakota people in South Dakota as a teacher and, later, parish pastor. At St. Louis University, Father Collins taught in the Theology Department and served as director of the Catholic Studies Program. Today, Father Collins serves as Saint Louis University's assistant to the president for Mission and Identity. In this role, Father Collins provides executive-level leadership for fostering and promoting SLU's Catholic, Jesuit identity in its operations, structures, programs and practices.

On Friday night Fr. Collins will share his thoughts on *The Mystery of Suffering*.

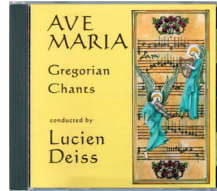
