

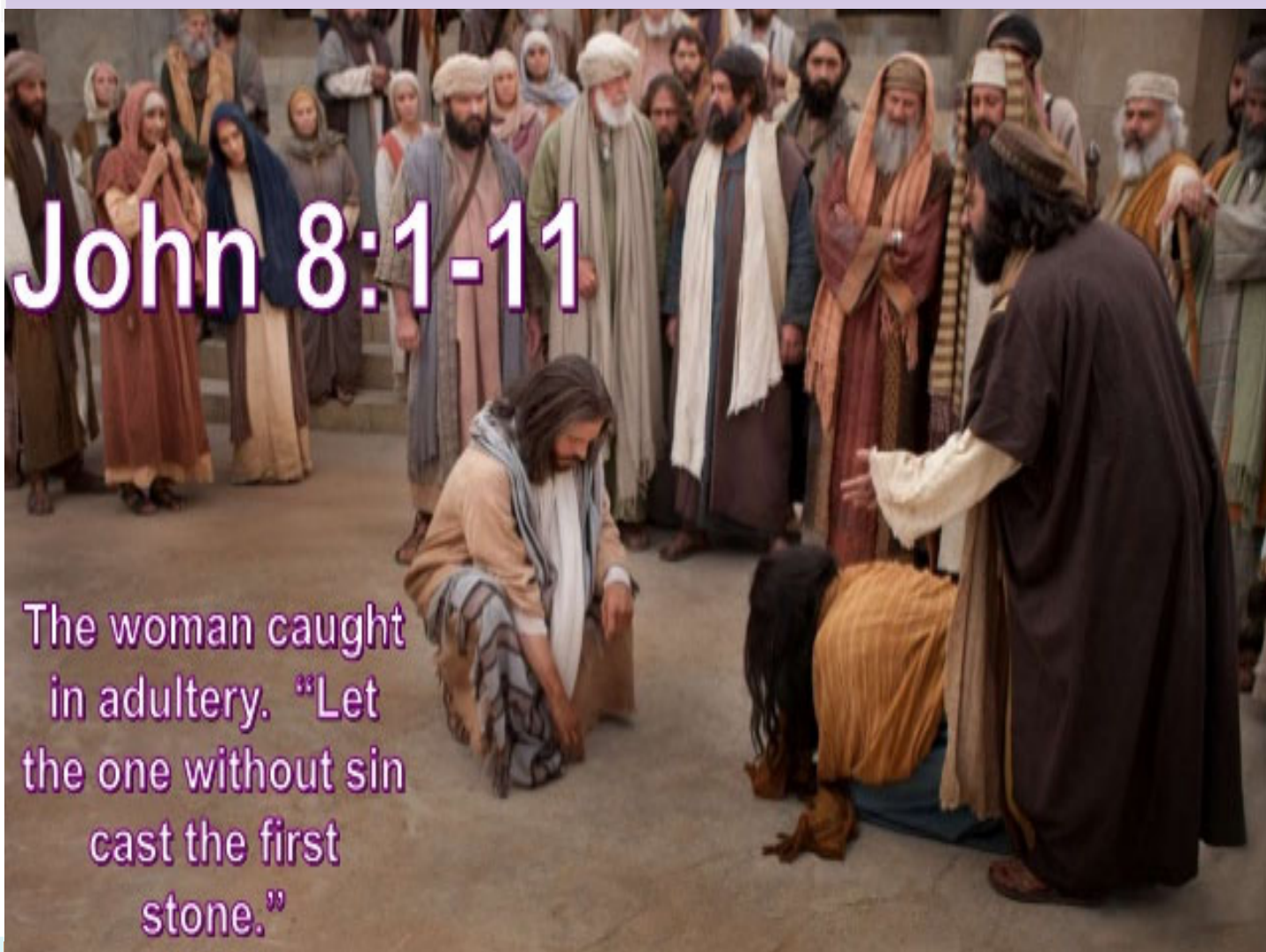

## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT APRIL IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE HOLY EUCHARIST!**

### **PASSIONTIDE**

The whole demeanor of the Lenten season changes on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, anticipating the events of Lent's last two weeks. The focus, beginning today, will now center most directly on the physical sufferings of the Savior. Consequently, in former times, this Sunday was called "Passion Sunday" and next Sunday "Palm Sunday"; now, today is simply called the "Fifth Sunday of Lent" and it's next Sunday that is officially called "Passion (Palm) Sunday". Nonetheless, the last two weeks of Lent are still known as "Passiontide", and the mood of the Church is distinctly more somber than the rest of the year, and even more solemn than the first part of Lent. We express this change of temper by the covering of the statuary in church. Since they represent heavenly realities and thus give us hope that salvation is possible for us, they are expressions of joy. Well, starting today, there is no joy in Mudville (or Shovelton), because God loved us so much as to become one of us to save us, and we tortured Him to death.

### **THE PASSION OF THE CHRIST**

In what is becoming a tradition here at St. Angela's, we'll be giving a special Holy Week showing of Mel Gibson's masterpiece, *The Passion of the Christ*. I think that it's a great preparation for the events of Holy Week, where we re-live the wonderful and dramatic things that God did to save us through His Beloved Son, who gave Himself selflessly over to a torturous death in order to effect that salvation. By showing us how horrible Christ's Sufferings were, Gibson communicates to us in the 21<sup>st</sup> century the same message Christ did in the 1<sup>st</sup>, namely, how abominable our sins are. For all its power and eloquence, it's still a very painful movie to watch, and so I urge caution; it well deserves its "R" rating (for violence). It will be shown in our lunchroom at 2:00PM.

### **A SIMPLE LENTEN SUPPER**

Our parish is going to serve a "Simple Lenten Supper" on the Friday before Palm Sunday (April 12). It will be, immediately, a preparation for the Stations of the Cross and guest speaker that evening, but it will also help us get ready for the great events of Holy Week. We will serve a variety of delicious (but meatless) soups, gourmet Italian bread (without dessert), and heaping portions of parish sociability. There will be no charge for it, but a donation will be taken for the Vincent de Paul Society. Dinner will be served in our lunchroom from 5:30-7:00PM.

### **CONFESSION TIMES**

Practically every saint who ever lived recommended and practiced frequent Confession. If they needed it, how much more do we! There will be special times this week: Tuesday, 11:30AM-noon, and 6:30-7:00PM (in addition to the usual time on Saturday from 4:00-4:45pm).

Steve has been a regular contributor to the daily devotional "Living Faith" for more than 30 years and is the author of a series of booklets for Catholic children, families, parents and parishes, published by a number of Catholic publishers, including Liguori Publications and Creative Communications for the Parish. Diagnosed in 2007 with a rare blood disease, Langerhans Cell Histiocytosis, he underwent chemotherapy treatment for more than three years; that experience was the subject of his book, "Embraced by God: Facing Chemotherapy with Faith." Steve Givens lives in St. Louis, Mo. with his wife, Sue. They have two grown and married children and three grandchildren.

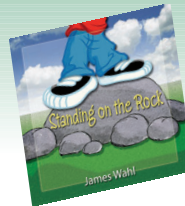
