REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!

MOTHER'S DAY

It is most fitting that in the month during which we honor the Blessed Mother, we also celebrate the secular feast of Mother's Day, which renders us the opportunity not only to honor our mothers (and grandmothers and great-grandmothers), but also to rejoice in God's gift of all women, which must surely rank as one of His greatest. And so a happy Mother's Day to all!

TRINITY GRADUATION

Trinity High School has asked to use our parish church this coming Thursday for its graduation Mass, and so we welcome them to St. Angela's for their 7:00PM graduation Mass. There are three alumni of our school in that graduating class, and so we congratulate them and their classmates, and all our graduates this year, for the successful completion of their academic programs!

IF YOU'RE EVER BORED DRIVING AROUND IN YOUR CAR...

...check this out: in the vestibule of church, kind of tucked-away in the corner, is a kiosk full of audio CD's (and some books) that promote and defend Catholic belief and practice. They are consistently very good. We operate on the "honor system", and encourage you to take the ones you want and drop \$3 per CD in the collection basket to pay for them. Most of the CD's have doctrinal content, i.e., they discuss and explain the finer details of Catholic doctrine, but some are very pastoral, in that they deal with the challenges of living a moral life in the 21st century. Some relate stories of personal faith journeys, which tend to be very engaging and compelling. I would like to call special attention to a CD of that last category, namely, the one by Abby Johnson, whose personal story is told, brilliantly, in the recent hit movie *Unplanned*. On this CD, you hear Abby tell her story of how she went from being Planned Parenthood's "Employee of the Year" (replete with a personal luncheon with Hilary Clinton!), to being a hard-core Pro-Lifer. It's a heart-warming story of a soul finding redemption in the grace of God and, at the same time, a forceful exposition of a sinister and diabolical organization, Planned Parenthood. Highly recommended!

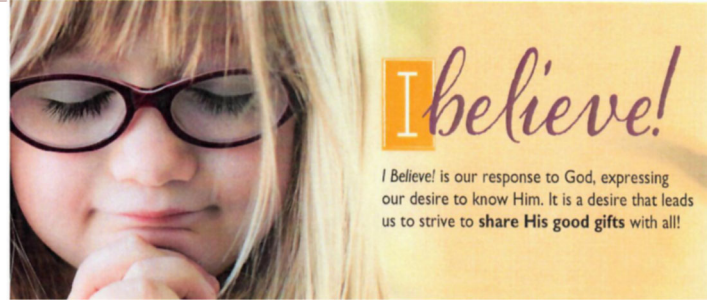
