From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!

SEX STRIKE?

For some reason, it was reported as news that Alyssa Milano (whoever she is) has called for a “sex strike” as a reaction against the passing of legislation protecting the rights of the unborn in various states. It probably says more about me than it does about her that I have no idea who she is, but I did some on-line research, and apparently she’s an aging ingénue with a languishing career whose “fifteen minutes of fame” are up, and is desperately trying to prove that she’s still relevant. She’s calling for this “strike” as a protest on behalf of “women’s rights” (naturally), seemingly oblivious to the irony of her remonstrance. The dictionary defines “irony” as “an intention or attitude opposite to that which is actually or ostensibly stated”. In calling for a “sex strike”, Ms. Milano is, in fact, calling for the true remedy, not only to the abortion question, but to all of the sundry ills inflicted upon the human race as the direct consequence of the Sexual Revolution of the 60’s. Calls for abstinence from sex (aka, “chastity”) are long overdue, especially from those who infest the region that is appropriately called “La-La Land”. 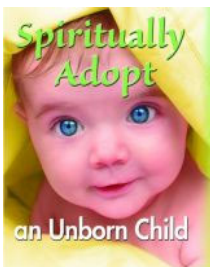

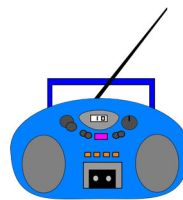
SPIRITUAL ADOPTION

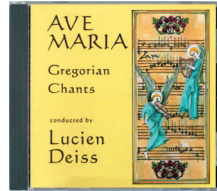

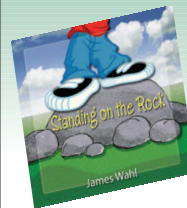
