From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!

FIRST COMMUNION DAY

This Sunday at the 11:30 Mass, two of our parishioners (both second graders) are making their First Holy Communion. They are: Samantha Mann and Joseph Hunt. Our congratulations both to them and their happy families! Every time we administer First Communion, it induces each of us to recall the first time that we receive the sacred Body and Blood of Our Lord In Holy Communion, to remember the joy of the day and the unique sensation we had of being privileged to take part in something that was not only a lot larger than we were, but something that was truly not of this world. That's precisely what Holy Communion is (and not just for the first time that it's received!).

THE SECOND GREAT WALL OF ST. ANGELA

A couple of summers ago, our crack and all-capable maintenance crew re-constructed the terraced walls in back of our outdoor Blessed Mother shrine, the ones that face the school building. They did a fabulous job, and now, with the assistance of some members of our faithful and horticulturally-correct Garden Society, they have re-done the old and rotting railroad-tie wall in front of church (the one between the church entrance and the library) in the same style as the other. Again, a wonderful job was done. Is it visible from space (like, allegedly, the one in China)? Probably not, but it's a lot more worth taking the trouble to see! 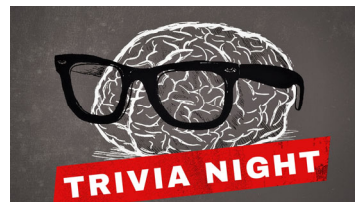
