## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

### **BACK TO THE OPERATING ROOM**

Twelve years ago, I had my right hip replaced. Three years ago I had my left one done, too. Now I need to go back in and have the right hip re-done. Apparently, it was done the first time with inferior parts, and so there has to be a clean-up of particles and replacement of, at least, the contact points. The simpler form of the surgery would involve the clean-up and replacement of the contact points; the more complex version would require removing all the old hardware and replacing it with new. The first option would require a lot less down time, and so I'm asking your prayers for that. The surgery is scheduled for July 30. I'll keep you abreast of all the latest developments...

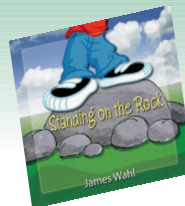
