## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

### **CALLING ALL CATECHUMENS!**

This is the time of year when we start looking at the next RCIA class, and so if either you or anyone you know is interested in becoming Catholic (or just learning more about our faith), please let me know as soon as possible. The classes will start almost immediately.

### **GERMANFEST: NEXT SATURDAY!**

The Germanfest is rapidly becoming the major parish activity of the year, and rightly so: a lot of work is going into it and it's going to be a great celebration of our parish community coming to work together and have a wonderful time. It starts next Saturday (Sept. 28) at 4:30 and goes until 10:00PM. There will be games for all ages, raffles with great prizes, bingo, music, and, of course, spectacular German food provided by Meister Chef, Don Krause. So stop by the lunchroom and order up a tee-shirt or polo, buy a bunch of chances for the prizes, and then bring the whole family next Saturday to the big feast!

### **MASS TIME FOR GERMANFEST**

As previously announced, there will be one change in the Mass schedule to accommodate Germanfest, and that is that the usual 5:00PM Mass on Sept. 28 will begin at 4:00, and the 4:00PM Confessions will take place at 3:00 instead. That is the only change and it is for that one day **ONLY!**

### **HURRICANE DORIAN**

Archbishop Carlson has asked all the parishes of the Archdiocese to take a collection for relief for the victims of the recent storms on the East Coast and Caribbean, so this is how we're going to do it: take a plain envelope, mark it with the words "HURRICANE RELIEF", write your name & address below that, and then put your offering inside it (checks should be payable to St. Angela) and drop it into the collection basket (or drop it off at the office) over the next couple of weeks.

### **CAN YOU HEAR ME NOW?**

As we get older, it shouldn't surprise us that we can't do things as well as what we used to. There's nothing in that to be ashamed of. Quite the contrary, it's something to be proud of, that we've made it as long as we have. (I particularly endorse the passage from the books of the Maccabees that speak of "the merited distinction of our grey hairs"!)

When our eyesight fails, we either get glasses or vision-corrective surgery, and it's no big deal. When the hearing starts to fail, however, a lot of people are reluctant to avail themselves of any kind of corrective measures. This is sad because it's so unnecessary. I don't know whether you're aware of this, but our parish owns a number of hearing devices that are connected directly to our church's sound system and are expressly for the use of our parishioners who need them. They're located in the choir area on a table right up against the side wall of church. They're in a box, where they are constantly being recharged. You simply disconnect the charging cable, stick the earpiece in your ear, turn it on, and enjoy the glorious sounds of our Catholic worship. Then, at the end of Mass, return it to its stations and re-connect the charging cable. St. Paul asked the question, "How can they know if they haven't heard?" Two thousand years later, we have a remedy for those who haven't been hearing! It's there to be used...enjoy!

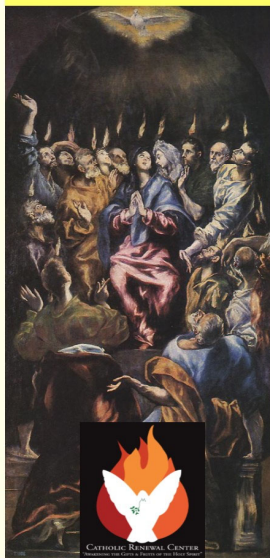

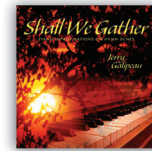

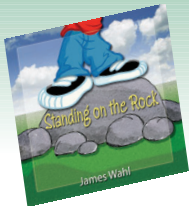
