## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT DECEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION AND JANUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY CHILDHOOD OF JESUS!**

### **THE HOLY FAMILY**

Every year, the Church sets aside the Sunday between Christmas and New Year's to celebrate the Holy Family, and with it, what the Vatican Council always referred to as the "Domestic Church". It's no secret that the institution of the family as Almighty God ordained and established it has taken a real beating in the past ten years, as out-of-control human entities (courts, legislatures, etc.) have attempted to re-define it. All kinds of alternative "arrangements", whose nature is only a sorry analog for a true family setting, are now, in law, given the same status as the real thing. Every society that has tried this in the past has placed itself on the short route to self-destruction. Now more than ever we need to celebrate and cherish and *defend* the wonderful gift of family. It was God's plan that everyone should learn to know and experience His love through the committed love of mother and father and the bonds of kinship that exist with siblings and grandparents. Because of the human element it sometimes fails, but it is the only *real* form of the family and cannot be improved upon, especially by those mere humans who are arrogant enough to think they can.

### **CHRISTMAS CAROL SING-ALONG**

Who else besides me remembers all the sing-alongs we had in the 60's? We had "Sing-along with Mitch (Miller)", "follow the bouncing ball", and every Shakey's Pizza had a guy in a red-and-white striped shirt and boater hat sitting at the piano and leading the singing in between bites of a sausage & peperoni (and it was the singing and not the pizza that drew the crowds!). And who else remembers what fun it was! We're going to have a sing-along this afternoon (Sunday), and it's all about Christmas Carols. You all know them. So bring your parish missalette with you and join us at 1:00PM in church, and bring the whole crew. It should be good!

### **THE DIVINE MATERNITY OF MARY**

One thing we Catholics have adapted from Judaism is that major feasts (Christmas & Easter) are celebrated for eight days, the last day (the Octave) being a very special one. And so we celebrate the Octave of Christmas to honor the Blessed Virgin as the true Mother of God with a holy day of obligation. This year's celebration will be a bit different. We will have the usual line-up of Mass at 5:00PM on New Year's Eve and 8:00AM on New Year's Day, but then later we will have a special 7:00 evening Mass, followed by a special talk as part of a program in conjunction with St. Joseph Catholic Radio. It's all a art of our holy hour for the sanctification of the parish that we usually have on each First Friday.

### **COVID**

Because of Christmas, I've had to submit bulletins weeks ahead of schedule, and so this is my first chance to talk about my recent bout with the world-wide pandemic. I was stunned to learn that I tested positive, mostly because I already had it 'way back in April and I really wasn't feeling that bad; I thought I had another sinus infection (which I get rather frequently because of my deviated septum). We followed all the CDC precautions as best we could, which, of course, was a big pain in the neck for the operation of our parish. Thanks for your cooperation and understanding, and a special thanks from me personally to our brother priests in our deanery who helped out (particularly Msgr. Ullrich and his deacon seminarian from Sacred Heart!) We're all fine now and ready to serve!

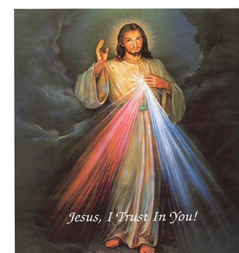

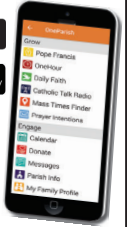
