## From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

**REMEMBER THAT JANUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY CHILDHOOD OF JESUS!**

### LITTLE CHRISTMAS

The long-established “Twelve days of Christmas” began on Dec. 25 and will end tomorrow (Monday) on the traditional date of the Epiphany. Liturgically, however, we celebrate that great feast today (since the Bishops’ Conference manhandled its celebration to always fall on Sunday). Why is it a great feast? Because it’s the first time that the new-born Emmanuel (“God with us”) showed Himself to the gentiles (through their representatives, the Magi). Hitherto, He had only made Himself accessible to Jews, viz., the shepherds of Bethlehem and the prophets, Simeon and Anna. In many European traditions, it’s the day when presents are given (it really does make a bit more sense, doesn’t it?), and so it’s called “Little Christmas”. In any case, Epiphany has its own customs, one of which is the blessing of the doors with blessed chalk. The number “20” is written on the top of the door, with the letters “C”, “M”, & “B” written straight down from the 20, and another 20 beneath the letters (the numbers vary from year to year). The C, M, & B stand for, “*Chistus mansem, benedicat*”, Latin for: “May Christ bless this mansion (house)” (or else it’s the initials of the three Magi, Casper, Balthassar, and Melchior). And so, may Christ and the blessings of His Epiphany come to your mansion!

### CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS

Over the past few weeks, I’ve had to come up with my bulletin columns weeks before they were published (even now, I’m writing this on Christmas Eve), and so I hadn’t yet seen how the church would be decorated. Well, now I have....WOW! Let me say it again...WOW! Words fail me in all my attempts to describe it. Don Krause and his crew have done it again, and we have all enjoyed it immensely. Our thanks to them all. At the same time, I would like to thank, in the name of our parish, all our musicians and singers, ushers and servers, lectors and Eucharistic ministers for their superlative and faithful service, too. This is just one more example of how much our people love our parish; I challenge any other parish to match what we have here!

**REQUIREMENTS** For every employee, Clergy and volunteers The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct.
