## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT NOVEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY!**

### **RCIA**

Normally, the RCIA is mechanism whereby the Church brings adult converts into full communion. We don't have any candidates for that this year, but a number of our parishioners expressed to me a desire to take part, and we're going to have the classes again, anyway, and everybody is invited to take part. We will gather in the Parish Meeting Room (located at the very end of the row of parish offices) on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & 5<sup>th</sup> Mondays of each month at 6:30. The sessions are free and last about an hour. We will start on Monday, Nov. 9.

### **RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE**

The need for blood for transplants is great, and so the Red Cross is coming to our parish once again to solicit donors to help save lives. ### **ELECTION HOLY HOUR**

Tomorrow (Monday) we will have a special holy hour from 7:00-8:00PM in the parish church, praying for the national election. It will begin with the Mass for All Souls' Day and conclude with Benediction at 8:00.

### **WHAT DO THEY STAND FOR?**

I have run off copies of a digest of the two major political parties' platforms that was prepared by the Priests for Life. The actual platforms are much bigger, and I encourage you to examine their full texts (they're available on line), but this is, as I say, a digest of the issues that have special pertinence for American Catholics. Everything on that sheet is a direct quote from their platforms.

### **ALL SAINTS'/SOULS' DAY**

Monday, Nov. 2, is All Souls' Day. It is not a holy day of obligation, but is a day when the Catholic faithful, understanding our obligation to pray for the dead and how beneficial our prayers for them are, have attended Mass. Three Masses, therefore, will be offered on All Souls' Day: 6:30 & 8:00AM, and 7:00PM. I also recommend that you visit the graves of your beloved dead that day.

### PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

#### For Every employee, Clergy and volunteers.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. **This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service.** For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to [www.preventandprotectstl.org](http://www.preventandprotectstl.org) to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button. Enter the **passcode stlprotect**. Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314 -838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.

### RACHEL'S VINEYARD

The Archdiocese of St. Louis is expanding its Abortion Healing Ministry through the addition of Rachel's Vineyard, an intensive weekend retreat. This ministry is considered the world's largest ministry for healing after abortion and to date has helped more than 320,000 women and men globally since its founding. This retreat is open to women, men and couples, and will take place Nov. 13-15. The program expands upon the existing Project Rachel and Project Joseph programs, both of which provide healing to women and men affected by an abortion. Rachel's Vineyard also offers up to six weeks of follow-up care after the retreat. A separate Bible study is offered to anyone who has participated in Rachel's Vineyard. 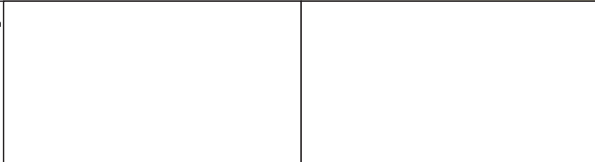
