REMEMBER THAT NOVEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY (pray for them!)!

VIVA CHRISTO REY!

That was the battle cry of the faithful Catholic Christero's in their fight against the persecutions of the oppressive socialist regime of Plutarco Calles: "Long Live Christ the King". In order to give them support in their struggle, Pope Pius XI instituted the great feast which we now celebrate this Sunday, the feast of Christ the King. The Mexican persecutions are now over, but the reality of the end of all things still remains, so now this feast is our liturgical expression of the theological mystery of the Four Last Things: death, judgement, heaven and hell. We know that Christ is coming again, but we don't know when ("Ye know not the day nor the hour"). It's a grim remainder of the judgement that we face, but it's also a glad promise of the glory that awaits those who remain faithful. With it, the Year of Grace 2021 finds its conclusion as we begin the new Year of Grace 2022 next week on the First Sunday of Advent.

LET US GIVE THANKS TO THE LORD, OUR GOD!

This Thursday, the 25th, is Thanksgiving Day. It is good that we thank the Lord and proper that we should appreciate everything He has given us and done for us. We will, therefore, express that thanks at our annual Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:00AM. The traditional blessed bread will be distributed after Mass and we will also have the offertory procession with non-perishable food items or money for the poor.

ADVENT VESPERS

We have the tradition here at St. Angela's to prepare for the coming of Christ in Advent by celebrating the Church's solemn Evening Prayer (or "vespers") on the evening of each of its four Sundays. The vespers starts in church at 7:00PM and involves the chanting of the psalms, canticles, and prophecies of the season, with Eucharistic Adoration as well. It's a unique, distinctive, traditional, and beautiful way to keep a good Advent (and it's something that particularly the little ones love, as it becomes, in their maturity, one of the most cherished memories of their childhood). This is a votive Mass in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary during Advent.

The name is taken from the traditional introit for the Mass: **Rorate caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum.** "Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain down the Just One." The distinctive feature of the Rorate Mass is that the church is entirely lit only by a great multitude of candles. The liturgy begins in darkness — this is the reason for the early starting time — but as it continues the light outside increases.

After Mass we will have a little breakfast reception – coffee, pastries, hot chocolate, maybe even some wassail. All are welcome! Spread the word, invite your friends and family!
