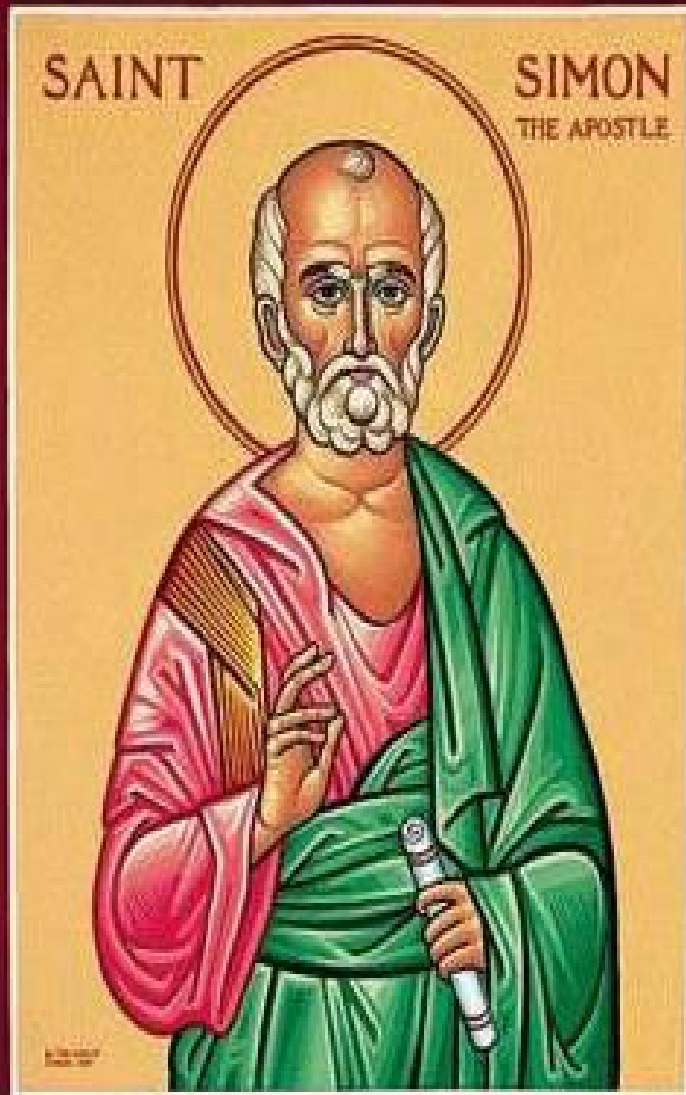

RCIA, MONDAY OCT. 18

As I mentioned here last week, the first order of business at our first RCIA session was to figure out when we were going to meet, picking a time that was agreeable to all. Well, we came up with one. We'll be meeting on Monday's at 4:30PM in the Parish Meeting Room. Again, all are welcome; it's a great opportunity to learn your Catholic faith in an adult way.

ALL SAINTS' DAY/ALL SOULS' DAY

Since it falls on a Monday this year (Nov. 1), it's not observed as a holy day of obligation. Nevertheless, it is still a big feast and so we will have Mass to honor all the Saints at 6:00PM. The day after All Saints' is All Souls, the traditional day for praying and performing works of penance on behalf of our beloved dead, and also for taking time to visit their graves. We will, therefore, in the place of the usual Tuesday evening devotions to end the Eucharistic Adoration, have Mass for the dead at 6:30PM (followed by Catechism Class).

ANSWERS: 1. *Sincere sorrow for offending God, hatred of our sins, firm purpose of amendment* 2. *Yes, but only if we have true contrition for it* 3. *The sorrow must be interior, supreme, supernatural and universal* 4. *When it comes from the heart and not just the lips* 5. *When we hate sin so much that we would endure any suffering to avoid it* 6. *When, motivated by grace, it is motivated by faith and not by some natural motive, e.g., fear of getting caught* 7. *When we are sorry for every mortal sin committed* 8. *Perfect and imperfect* 9. *When the sorrow for our sins is based on having offended God whom we should love above all* 10. *When our sorrow for sin is based on the hatefulness of our sins or fear of punishment*

Growing up in an abusive household, Crystal became the victim of child trafficking after being abandoned on an inner city street by her biological mother at the age of 12. After escaping the traffickers and helping the FBI with their arrest, Crystal's homeless life style took a toll on her physical and mental health, resulting in an extended hospitalization, during which she was befriended by a Christian security guard who kept reminding her that God would help her if she gave Him a chance. After release from the hospital, she started each day with prayer, while living under a bridge. It was here that Crystal started her non-profit ministry, **Jesus in Disguise**, through which she helps the poor, homeless, and addicts, both materially and spiritually. At an award dinner on September 26th, Crystal was honored as Catholic Woman of the Year for SJEN-St. Joseph Radio by Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski.

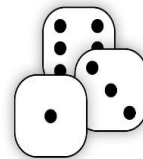
Have you heard His call to help others?
