### **VITAMIN D, PART II**

I wrote in this space a couple of weeks ago in praise of the beneficial effects of vitamin D. This vitamin is essential for the normal health of the body and, as such, one's levels of it should always be in the normal range. The body produces it naturally whenever we're exposed to sunlight. Sadly, most of us who live north of the 38<sup>th</sup> parallel (St. Louis is located *right at* the 38<sup>th</sup> parallel) don't get enough sun and so we need to compensate by taking D3 supplements. This is true all the time. But the reason why I'm writing about it again is because the new research regarding this vitamin is coming in waves and it is now overwhelmingly well-established that vitamin D is exceedingly effective both in the prevention of the covid and the diminution of its effects. Again, I'm not a doctor and I'm not claiming that it's a panacea or miracle drug, but a number of my friends which many are physicians and they're pretty much unanimous about the benefits of keeping your D levels up.
