9. This St. Louis native made a name for himself in horror films and became Catholic after getting married to his Catholic wife.
10. This four-time Oscar nominee, a beauty of the 30's & 40's, became a TV hit with "The Big Valley" in the 60's. She became Catholic when she married her husband.

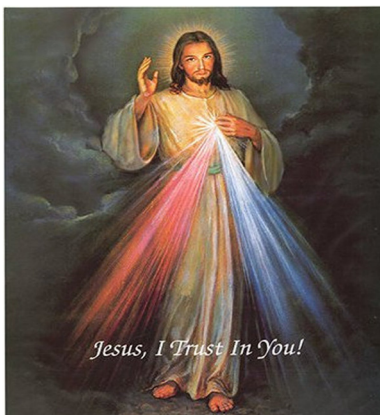


MEN'S CLUB SPRING PIZZA/DESSERT SALE

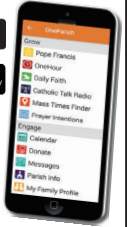
