REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!

EMANCIPATION!

It's official: NO MORE MASKS! Once you have been vaccinated, you no longer need to wear one. You'll notice, too, that our pews are no longer roped off. You are still advised to keep a "social distance", but I'm trusting your adult judiciousness and prudence to keep yourselves and everyone else safe. Also, our ushers are back in action taking up the collection and organizing the offertory procession.

PENTECOST

Today, the Easter season ends with the big bang festival of Pentecost, and with it, the last of our big church decorations until next Christmas. Our sanctuary is draped with the tongues of flame, the form through which the Divine Spirit descended upon the Apostles and the Blessed Mother. Often called the "birthday of the Church", Pentecost's arrival of the Holy Spirit was the fulfillment of Christ's promise both to send the Spirit and to be with us until the end. Let us rededicate ourselves to our Confirmation, when we renewed our baptismal commitment to serve and witness to Christ and His Church.

Final Farewell Party

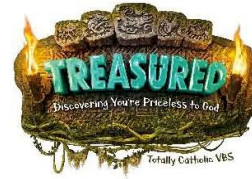

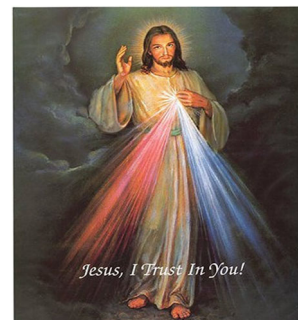

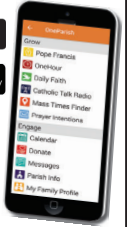
