From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY AND JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!

FIRST FRIDAY/SATURDAY

This coming Friday, June 4, is First Friday, and so we're going to have our usual line-up, namely, Mass on Friday evening at 6:00, and then, the next day, June 5, being First Saturday, we'll have Mass again at 8:00AM, followed by a mild repast and then the speaker series. This Saturday, our speaker will be radio and tv program host, Raymond Gerard. All are welcome!

THE HOLY TRINITY

Our Mother (the Catholic Church) asks us to ponder her two greatest mysteries on the two Sundays after Pentecost. Technically, we're in the green season of the year (Ordinary Time), but you won't be seeing any green on Sunday until June 13. That's because today we contemplate the mystery of the Holy Trinity, and next Sunday, the mystery of the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. By definition, a mystery is a truth that we know, but even though the Spirit does lead us to a great understanding of it, we will never be able to comprehend it completely. How do we know it? One reason and one reason only: God has revealed it, because it's something we would never have come up with on our own without His giving us the big clue. So let us make like real Catholics and glory in the grace by which God was pleased to grant us His favor!

IN HONOR OF ST. BONIFACE

You definitely do not want to miss out on our German Food Night next Saturday on the feast of St. Boniface, who is to the Germans what St. Patrick is to the Irish. Better act fast, because the tickets are selling like *kartoffelpfannkuchen* (German potato pancakes)! Only \$15 per person, which entitles you to the whole menu and your beverage, *bier, wein, usw.* (beer, wine, etc.).

AND DON'T FORGET CORPUS CHRISTI!

We are again having the traditional and immemorial Florissant Corpus Christi Procession, which follows the ancient path from Sacred Heart to the Old St. Ferdinand Shrine (about half a mile, all downhill). It will be all outdoors this year (unless it rains) and we will have the traditional repast at its conclusion. It starts at 7:00PM (in the cool of the evening) on Sunday June 6th. Let's let our Catholic faith shine forth in this uniquely Catholic expression of it...LET'S FILL THE STREETS!

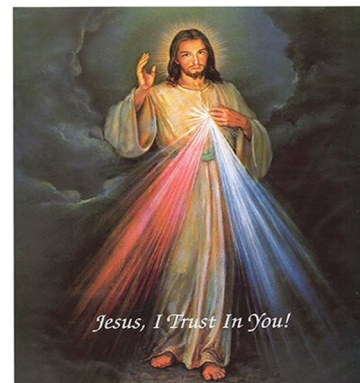

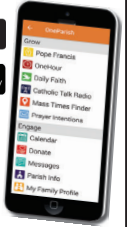
