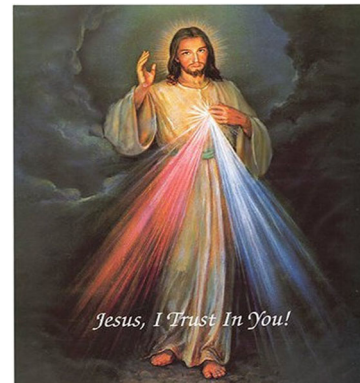

ST. FERDINAND FISH FRY IS OPEN!

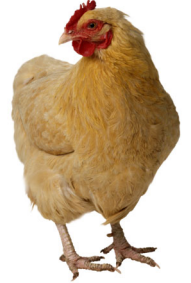
CARRY OUT or DINE IN

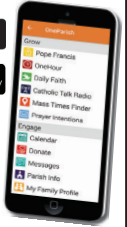

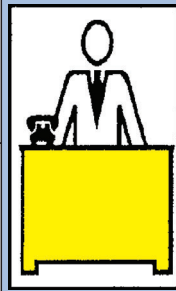
