## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

***REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!***

### **THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF JESUS...**

...truly present in the Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist – *that* is what we're celebrating today. As I've mentioned before, our Mother, the Church, asks us to ponder the two greatest mysteries revealed to us by God Himself on the two Sundays after Pentecost. Last Sunday, we considered the mystery of the Triune Divinity of God. This week, our contemplation focuses on the fact that Christ is truly present in the wafer and chalice at Mass. The appearances and forms do not change: the bread still looks and tastes like bread, same thing for the wine. By the power of Christ, however, and consistent with His pledge to make it happen, the substance of those humble, earthly things is transmuted into the very substance of the Living God Himself. We've developed a word to describe this miracle: **TRANSUBSTANTIATION**. Although it does not explain the phenomenon, it lets us know what has taken place. Why on earth do we believe this? One reason, and one reason only: Jesus said so. In the 6<sup>th</sup> chapter of St. John's Gospel, He promised that He would provide us with a kind of bread that those who partook of it would live forever, and further clarified that this bread would be His very Flesh. He even went further and explained that unless we did partake of this bread, we would have no life within us. He later identified Himself as the True Vine and we His branches, explained that connected to Him, He would feed us with His own substance, in the same way that the vine nourishes its branches, so that we would not only live, but bear fruit. Finally, at the Last Supper, He took the bread and said: **THIS IS MY BODY**, and with the wine: **THIS IS MY BLOOD**. Why would any of us ever doubt that the Eucharist is exactly what the Lord said it is?

### **FIRST COMMUNION**

Every Catholic remembers his First Communion Day, and for good reason. No, it's not just the party and the presents, but there's something more. Even as little ones, we know the big difference between the Eucharistic Bread and the normal table bread, and perhaps the little ones understand it better than we older folks do. They don't question it or try to figure it out; they just believe. Today, at our 9:30AM Mass, young Michael Quinlan of our parish is making his First Holy Communion. Our congratulations to him and his whole family!

### **THE GREAT TRADITIONAL FLORISSANT CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION**

Rain or shine, we're marching this Sunday night in procession with, and in adoration of, the Most Blessed Sacrament. It starts at 7:00PM at Sacred Heart and, weather permitting, will end at Old St. Ferdinand, where refreshments and transportation back to Sacred Heart will be provided. **LET'S FILL THE STREETS!** (If it rains, we'll do it all indoors, at Sacred Heart.)

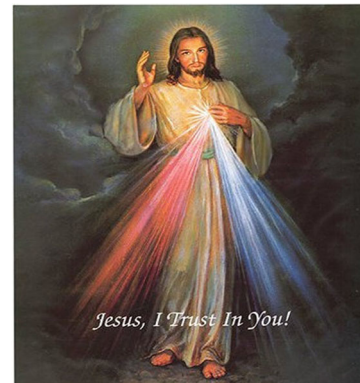

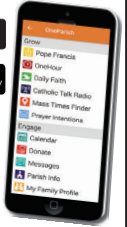
