Our doughnut suppliers are taking this weekend off to honor our great nation, and so we will not be serving doughnuts today. We will, however, be offering them next Sunday, July 11, so that you will still be able to get your USDA requirements of sugars, starches, and fats this month!

The Piper family is welcoming us again to the chapel attached to their home for a special Mass on the feast of St. Katherine Tekakwitha, July 14th. The procedure will be the same as in the past: 1) either meet here at SAM at 4:30pm and carpool together, or else meet at the chapel at 5:30pm (for those who know the way), 2) after Mass go over to the Madison Café for a fine meal together, and 3) sign up on the sheet where they sell scrip (so we can make a reservation at the restaurant). 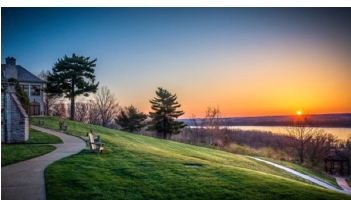


Features:

TAX INFORMATION

Charitable donations made directly from a traditional IRA can save taxes. People 70 ½ and older can transfer up to \$100,000 yearly from IRAs directly to charity. If married, you and your spouse can give up to \$100,00 each from your separate IRAs. Qualified charitable distributions can count as RMDs, but they are not taxable, and they are not added to your AGI. You cannot deduct the donation on Schedule A. The Ira-to-charity strategy can be good way to get tax savings from charitable gifts for taxpayers not taking charitable write-offs because of higher standard deductions.

The money from the IRA must go directly to a charitable organization. Transfers to a donor advised fund, charitable gift annuity, charitable remainder trust or any other life-income or split-interest gift arrangement are not treated as QCDs.

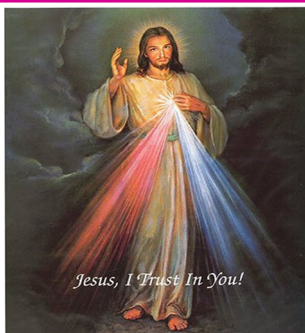

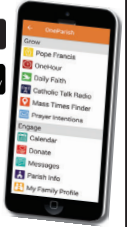
