Ever since our parish was blended with St. Christopher and Transfiguration (the western half, anyway) in 2005, we at St. Angela have always taken the occasion of the feast of the Transfiguration (August 6) to have an ice cream social on the Saturday closest to it. This year is no exception. Plan on coming to the big gala ice cream social on Saturday, August 6, after the 5:00PM Mass in the lunchroom. It should be a great time!

LIGUORIAN MAGAZINE

Fr. PRAISING GOD THE FATHER

For the past eight years now, our parish has provided the site for the annual Mass in honor of God the Father. The origin of this observance goes back to 1932, when an Italian nun, Mother Eugenia Ravasio, claimed to have received apparitions from God the Father asking for this feast to be established. While it is not formally recognized by the Church and ratified as an authentic apparition, it is not condemned and is subject to investigation by the Church. In this regard, it is in exactly the same place where the Feast of Corpus Christi found itself in the 13th century. And while there is no specific liturgy for this feast day (which Mother indicated was to be celebrated on the first Sunday of August), there is nothing bizarre or heretical about praising God the Father, using the given liturgy for the 19th Sunday of Ordinary Time. That is what we will do. This is the only parish in the Archdiocese where this feast is being observed, and, typically, many come here from all over the Archdiocese. This Mass will, of course, fulfill your Sunday obligation.

WE'RE SERIOUS ABOUT THIS

Many people have already accepted our blanket invitation to come and have lunch with your pastor and parish staff at noon on Monday-Thursday. When I first presented this invitation, I meant it, and still do, as many have found it. We typically have a wonderful time and get to know each other a great deal more. All I ask of you is that you call and speak with me or a member of the staff to arrange the best day and time when we can all be together!

DID you know that for every extra pound of body fat you carry, your heart needs to pump blood through an extra mile's worth of blood vessels; an immense burden on your heart? For instance, if you are 10 pounds overweight, there are 10 extra miles of blood vessels you are carrying around. Obesity also increases your likelihood of developing arteriosclerosis (fatty deposits on the inner walls of blood vessels), diabetes, and high blood pressure, all of which put you at a greater risk for heart attacks and strokes. Obesity also makes it more difficult to remain active. The more sedentary your lifestyle is, the greater your risk for heart disease. Fortunately, by reducing your weight to normal levels, you can also reduce your risk of developing these disorders. Incorporate a healthy, balanced eating plan with a regular exercise program (heart-strengthening aerobic exercise if possible). According to the American Heart Association, the healthiest diet is one that limits sodium to no more than 3,000 mg per day, cholesterol to no more than 300 mg per day and fats to no more than 30% of your caloric intake per day. For exercise and heart health it is important to exercise vigorously for 20-30 minutes 3-5 times per week. Join your fellow parishioners in one of the following exercise programs to begin your path to a healthy heart.

- **Arthritis Exercise Classes:** new session starting August 22nd on Mondays and Thursdays at 9:00 am. Cost is \$10 for 16 classes. We meet in the Parish Hall at 1220 Paddock Dr.
- **Zumba Aerobic Dance Classes:** starting August 22nd and will meet on Mondays and Thursdays 6:30 – 7:30 in the Parish Hall. Cost is \$10.00 for 16 classes. It is a Latin-inspired dance recipe for success. Take some meringue, add a little samba, sprinkle it with mambo and add a spoonful of salsa and you have Zumba!


